

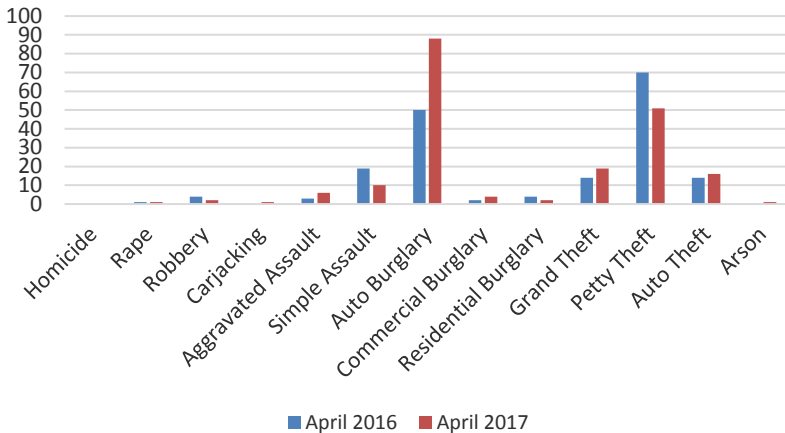

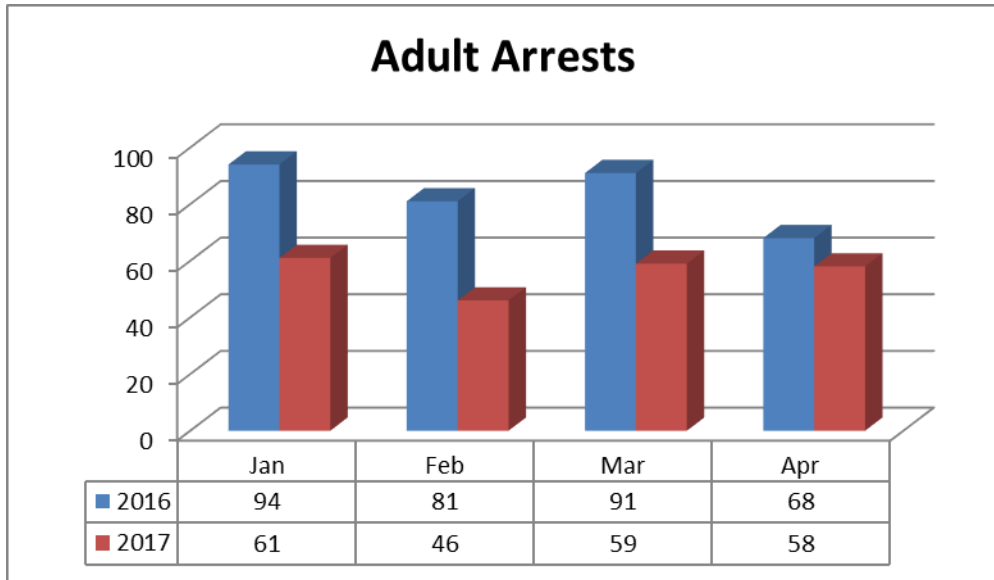

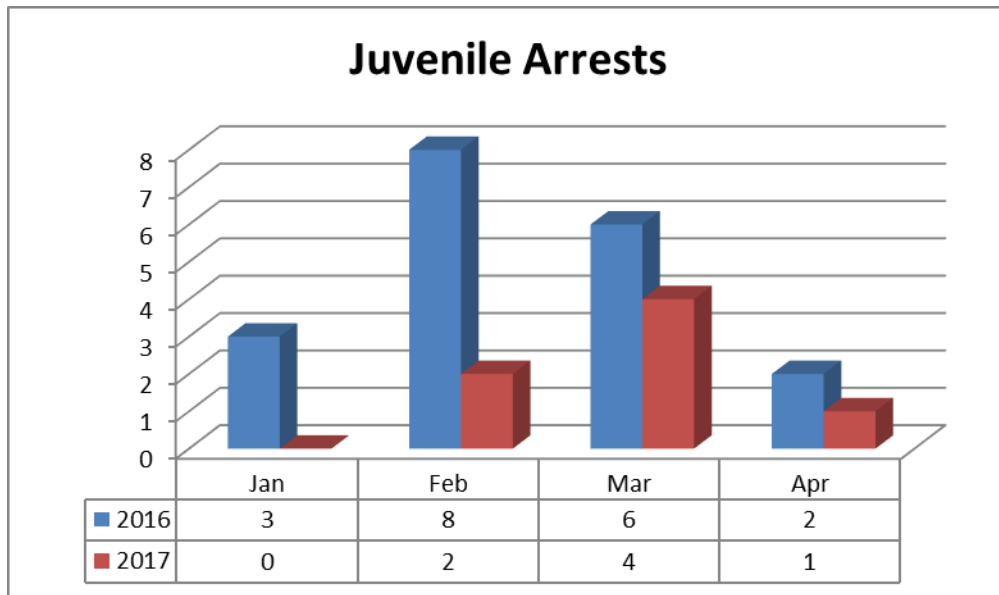

Rape: In District 3 in the 6401 block of Shellmound St., a sexual assault occurred. The victim knows the suspect.

Robbery: In District 3 at Urban Outfitters, 5903 Shellmound St., a shoplifter used force to steal clothing from the business. In District 5 at Zumiez, 5677 Bay St., a juvenile shoplifter concealed items and brandished a knife at an employee. EPD arrested the juvenile shortly thereafter.

Car Jacking: In District 8 in front of 3994 Adeline St., a suspect pushed the victim down, got into the victim's vehicle and fled. The victim's vehicle was idling at the time of the theft. Vehicle: 6D76336 1992 Chevy Van, white.

Aggravated Assault: In District 3 at 65th & Christie Ave., a domestic violence incident resulted in a physical fight, in which the male punched and kicked the female. EPD arrested the male shortly thereafter. In District 4 at 7 Captain Dr., a domestic violence incident resulted in a male hitting and kicking his wife. In District 5 at Ohlone Wy., & Shellmound St., a motorist nudged a cyclist from behind while she was on her bicycle. The motorist then made a U-turn and yelled obscenities at the cyclist. The cyclist was not injured. At 5750 Christie Ave., A domestic violence incident resulted in the male punching the female in the face causing injury. EPD arrested the male shortly thereafter. In District 8 in front of 3801 San Pablo Ave., a suspect threw a bottle at a male citizen and struck the citizen on the arm with a wooden stick. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. In District 9 at Pak n Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave., a shoplifter attempted to steal and threw a wine bottle at a store employee. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter.

Commercial Burglary: In District 5 at the Kiosk 5625 Bay St., POE: Door – Pried. LOSS: Imitation jewelry. In District 7 at Granite Expo, 1368 40th St., a suspect entered the business and rifled through the drawers in the office. LOSS: Credit cards. In District 8 at All About the Dogue Salon & Spa, 3850 San Pablo Ave #105., POE: Security gate defeated, unlocked door entered. LOSS: iPad. In District 9 the Deli at Home Depot, 3838 Hollis St., (Attempt burglary). An unknown suspect attempted to break into the storage area for the Deli.

Residential Burglary: In District 1 at 108 Liquid Sugar Dr., POE: Garage door knob pried. LOSS: Bicycle. At 1259 Peabody Ln., POE: Unknown. LOSS: (1) TV and (1) laptop computer.

Auto Theft: (14) vehicles & (2) motorcycles were stolen. Ford pick-up trucks were popular. (8) Vehicles were recovered, (5) of which were recovered intact, (2) vehicles were damaged, (1) vehicle was burned. (8) Vehicles are still outstanding.
