

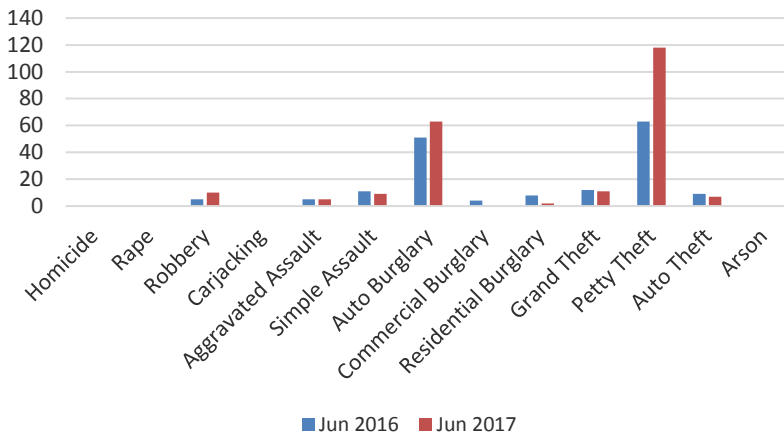

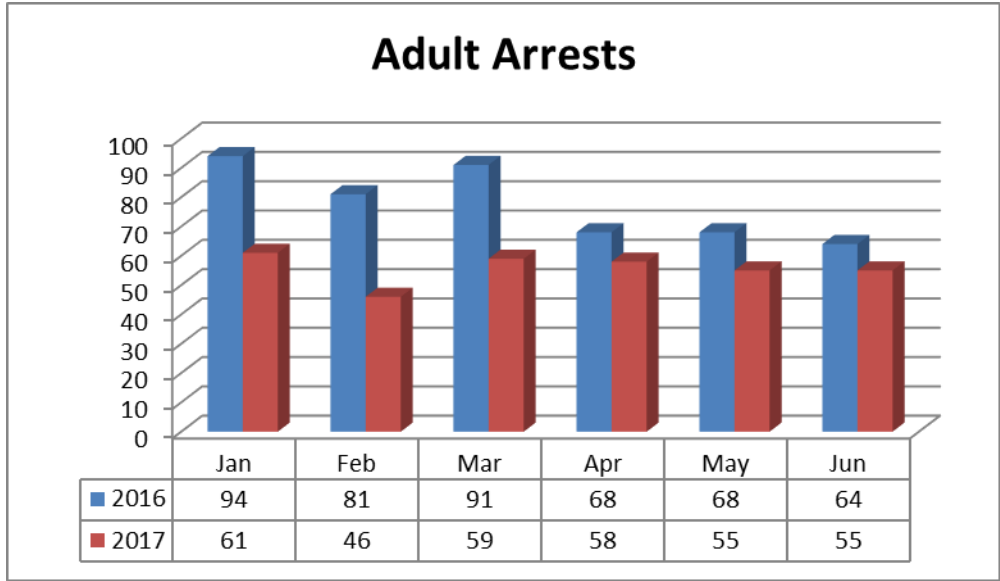

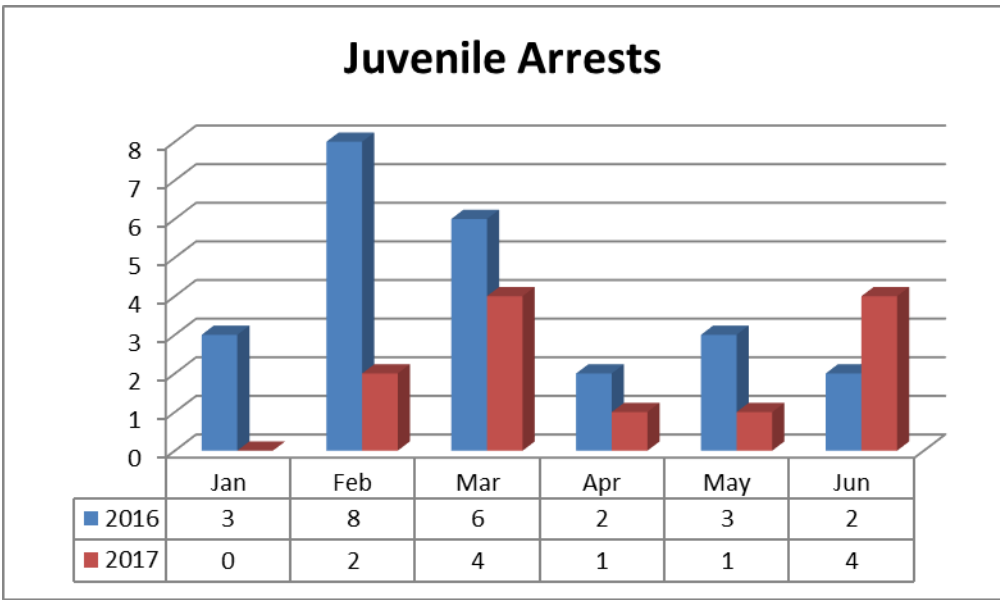

Robbery: In District 2 at Starbucks, 1405 65th St., two male juvenile suspects, 13-18 years old, robbed two individuals of their laptops and fled the area. In District 3 at the 76 Station, 1700 Powell St., a male suspect reached over the counter, grabbed a pack of cigarettes and threatened to punch the cashier in the face. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. In District 5 at the Apple Store, 5640 Bay St., four male suspects entered the store. One of the suspects proceeded to the cell phone display and removed four iPhones. All suspects pushed past security dropping three cell phones as they fled the scene. Security recovered the damaged phones. In the parking lot of the Four Points Sheraton, 1603 Powell St., three males and a female robbed a male victim of his cell phone, laptop, and clothing. In District 7 at the Oaks Club, 4097 San Pablo Ave., a male suspect removed a stack of Oaks Club chips valued at \$2000. The suspect fled the scene pushing a security guard through a glass door. The security guard was not injured. In District 8 on the 4500 block of San Pablo Ave., a male suspect punched another male knocking him off his bicycle. The suspect continued punching the victim, then took the victim's cell phone and bicycle. In District 9 at Nordstrom Rack, 3839 Emery St., #100 a female detained for shoplifting, pepper sprayed a loss prevention officer to avoid detention. The suspect fled the scene, however the loss prevention officer recovered the merchandise.

At Home Depot, 3838 Hollis St., a male shoplifter tried to elbow strike a loss prevention officer to avoid detention. The suspect fled, however the loss was recovered. **In District 10 at Target 1555 40th St.**, a male shoplifter fought with a loss prevention officer to avoid detention. The suspect fled with the merchandise. However, EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. **At Target, 1555 40th St.**, a female shoplifter fought with a loss prevention officer to avoid detention. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter.

Aggravated Assault: In District 5 at the Bay Street Mall, 5601 Shellmound St., a male juvenile discharged a paintball gun at a group of people. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. **In District 7 at CVS, 4349 San Pablo Ave.**, a male suspect shot another male in the abdomen with a pellet gun. **In District 8 in front of the Oasis Pamper Bar, 3823 San Pablo Ave.**, a male suspect struck another male with broomstick. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. **In District 9 at Little Caesar's Pizza, 1199 40th #300**, a dissatisfied customer pepper sprayed an employee. EPD arrested the customer shortly thereafter. **In the parking lot of Home Depot, 3838 Hollis St.**, an angry male suspect nearly hit a male pedestrian with his vehicle. The suspect was angry over a parking space.

Residential Burglary: In District 1 at 5860 Beaudry St. #C POE: No sign of forced entry. The resident found the front door ajar. LOSS: A safe. **In District 9 at 1321 40th St., #224** (Attempt) a witness saw a male suspect attempting to pry the front door with a pry bar. The suspect realized he was being watched and fled the area.
