

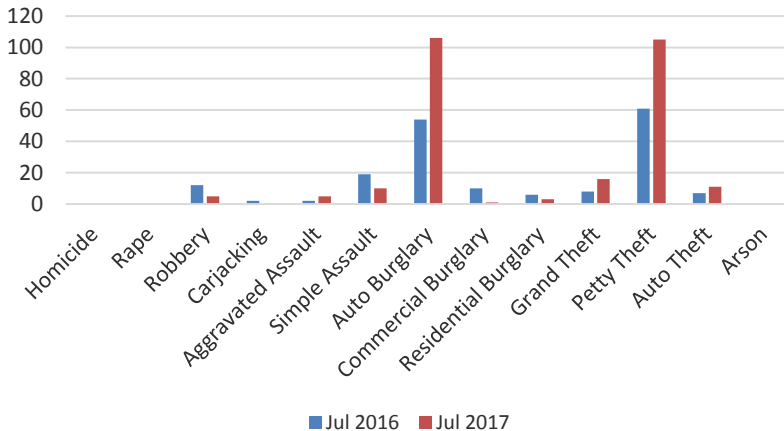

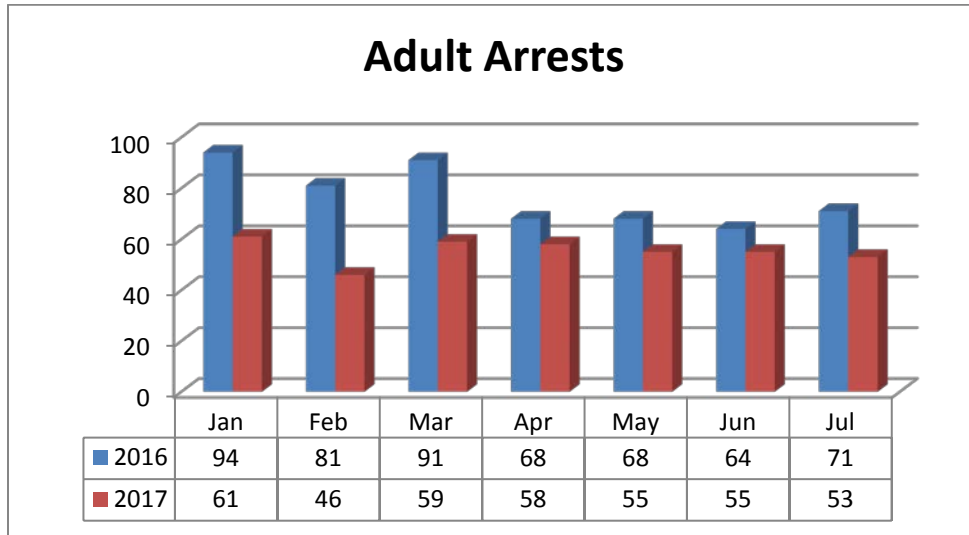

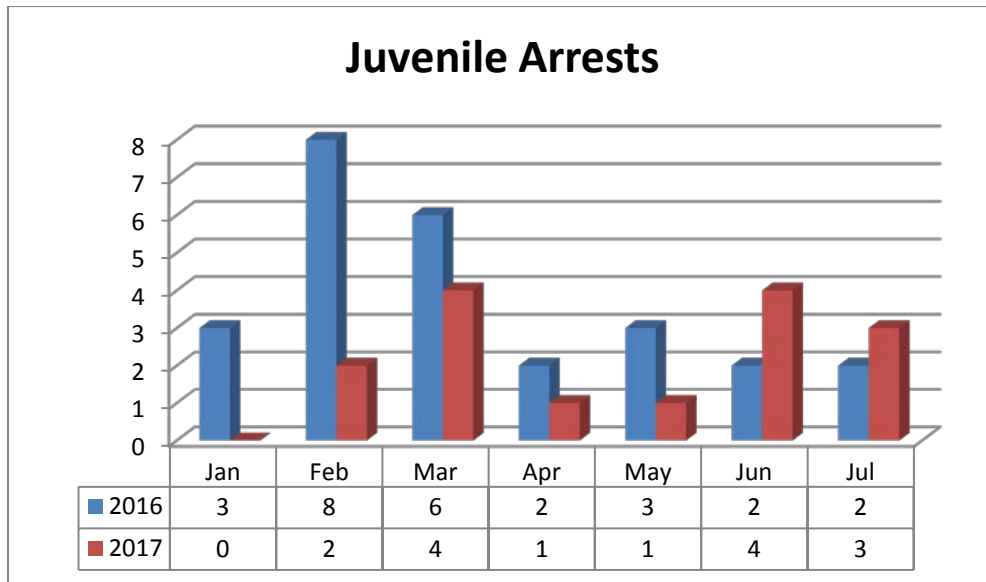

Robbery: In District 5 at Starbucks Coffee, 5767 Christie Ave., a group of male teenagers entered Starbucks and took a laptop from a table, a cell phone from another table, and fled to different vehicles. A customer chased after the suspects, however was unsuccessful in apprehension or recovering the loss. In District 5 near the 40th Street over crossing, two males and a female robbed two other females of their cell phones. In District 6 in front of the Broken Rack, 5768 Peladeau St., a male suspect revealed a gun in his waistband and robbed a male photographer. LOSS: A camera bag containing (2) Cameras, an iPad, and an a LBL Promaster. In District 7 at Park/Harlan St., a male citizen witnessed suspects burglarizing a vehicle. The citizen used his cell phone to record the incident, however the suspect robbed him of his cell phone and fled the area. In District 9 at Sally's Beauty 3839 Emery St. #600 two older male suspects entered the store, walked behind the counter and grabbed multiple packages of hair clippers. Both suspects fled the business on foot with the loss. LOSS: (10) Hair Clippers.

Aggravated Assault: In District 3 in the parking lot of the 76 Station, 1700 Powell St., an argument between an ex-boyfriend/ex-girlfriend resulted in the female hitting the male with her vehicle. The victim sustained minor injuries. EPD arrested the female shortly afterwards. In the 6400 block of Christie Ave., a male suspect slapped his girlfriend on both sides of her face causing injury.

In the 6401 block of Shellmound St., a domestic violence incident resulted in a male choking a female. The female declined medical attention. **District 7 at Park Ave/Emery St.**, a male suspect from a previous verbal altercation on 43rd St./Adeline St., was found lying in the street beaten up and bleeding from his face and head. **In District 9 in front of Nordstrom's, 3839 Emery St., #100**, a male suspect unknown to the victim, struck the victim on the head with a baseball bat causing serious injuries.

Commercial Burglary: In District 9 at Home Depot, 3838 Hollis St., an unknown male suspect entered the store during business hours, removed a tool from his pocket and pried open a cash register drawer. The suspect saw the drawer was empty and left the building.

Residential Burglary: In District 2 on the 6466 block of Hollis St., POE: Garage door. LOSS: Bicycle. **In District 8 on the 4200 block of Adeline St.**, POE: Unknown – No sign of force. LOSS: Power tools, a tool box, a sewing machine, and \$5 cash. **On the 4100 block of Adeline St.**, an unknown suspect attempted to break in. POE: Window – Broken. No entry.

Auto Theft: (11) Vehicles reported stolen, (2) of which were motorcycles. (6) Vehicles are still outstanding, (5) Vehicles were recovered.
