

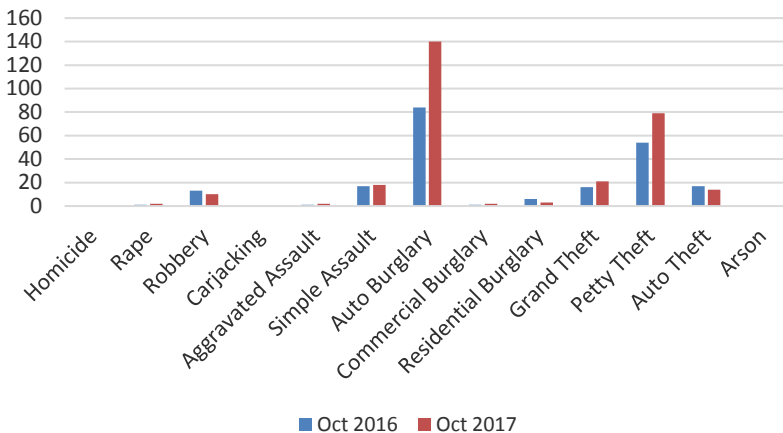

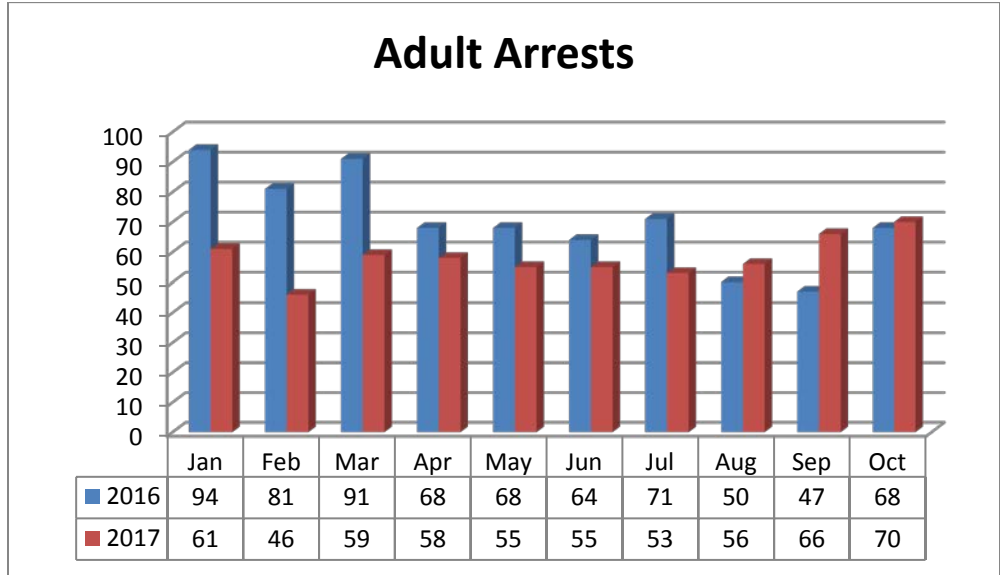

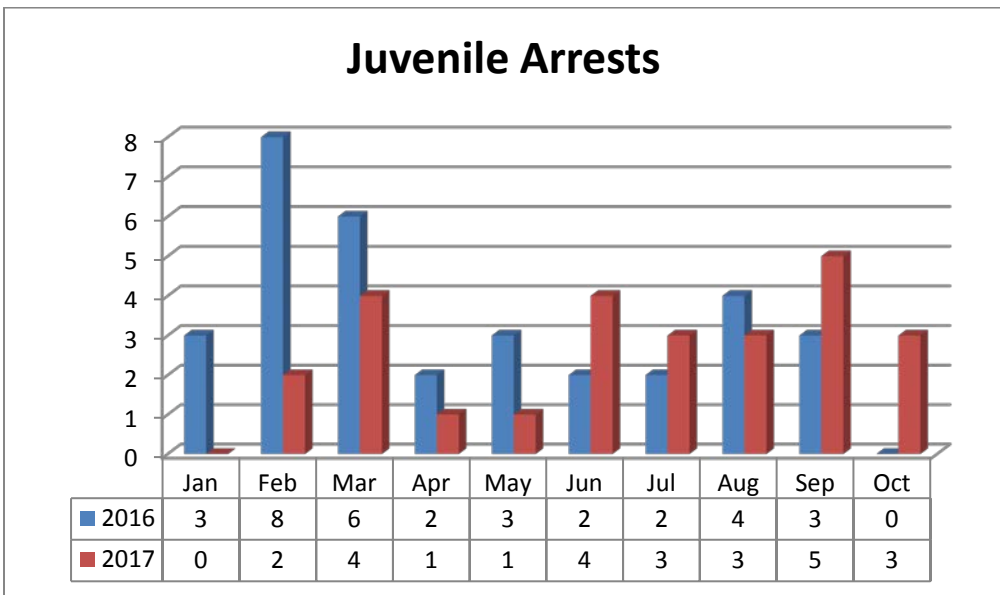

Rape: In District 5 on the 5600 block of Bay St., a female reported being raped by a male acquaintance. On the 1603 block of Powell St., a female reported being raped by a male acquaintance

Robbery: In District 5 on the 5600 block of Bay St., a female was robbed of her cell phone. Suspects: (2) males. At Zumiez, 5677 Bay St., three female shoplifters entered the store, stuffed clothing in bags and used force flee the store without paying. Near the Courtyard by Marriot, 5555 Shellmound St., a male suspect brandished a firearm and robbed a female of her cell phone. At Lenscrafters, 5707 Christie Ave., a shoplifter entered the store, selected several pairs of designer glasses from the display and used force to flee the store without paying. In District 7 at Wings Stop, 4133 San Pablo Ave., an older male stole an employee's phone from the counter and intimidated the employee when she asked him to return the phone. The employee continued to ask for her phone, the suspect returned the phone and fled the area. In District 9 at Nordstrom Rack, 3839 Emery St., # 100 a female shoplifter selected clothing and left the store without paying. Loss Prevention attempted to recover the merchandise and a brief struggle ensued. The suspect fled with one pair of jeans, and Loss Prevention recovered the other clothing.

At Toys R Us, 3938 Emery St., a female shoplifter concealed merchandise in her purse and used force to flee the store without paying. **At Pak N Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave.**, a female shoplifter selected and concealed seafood in her back pack and used force to flee without paying. **In District 10 at Target, 1555 40th St.**, a female shoplifter concealed merchandise and used force to flee the store without paying. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. **At Target, 1555 40th St.**, a male shoplifter brandished a knife at Loss Prevention to flee the store with concealed merchandise. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter.

Aggravated Assault: In District 5 at Sephora, 5626 Bay St., a detained shoplifter became angry, grabbed a pair of scissors and charged at the loss prevention officer. **In District 7 in the Oaks Club parking lot**, an irate patron attempted to run over a security guard with his vehicle. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter.

Commercial Burglary: In District 2 at 62nd/Horton St., (Construction site). POE: Window, wire screen cut and bent open. LOSS: (2) CCTV Cameras. Suspects: (2) Males, and (1) Female. **In District 7 at City Hall, 1333 Park Ave.**, POE: Unknown. An unknown suspect gained access to the building and slept there. LOSS: Laptop.

Residential Burglary: In District 4 at 3310 Powell St., (Boat) POE: Main entrance – lock cut. LOSS: Outboard motor, a sail, and an antenna. **In District 7 on the 1300 block of Powell St.**, an attempted burglary occurred. An unknown suspect attempted to pry the front door open, but did not make entry. **In District 8 on the 1000 block of 47th St.**, a male forced open his girlfriend's front door and took their two-month-old son. The father returned their son and was arrested by EPD.

Auto Theft: (14) Vehicles were stolen including (1) motorcycle. (9) Vehicles were recovered, (7) of which were recovered intact, (1) vehicle was damaged, and (1) vehicle was minor stripped. Honda Accords and Ford pick-up trucks were popular.
