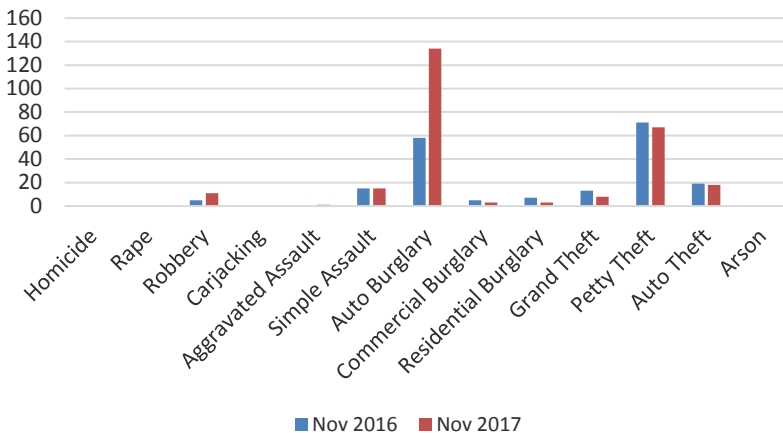

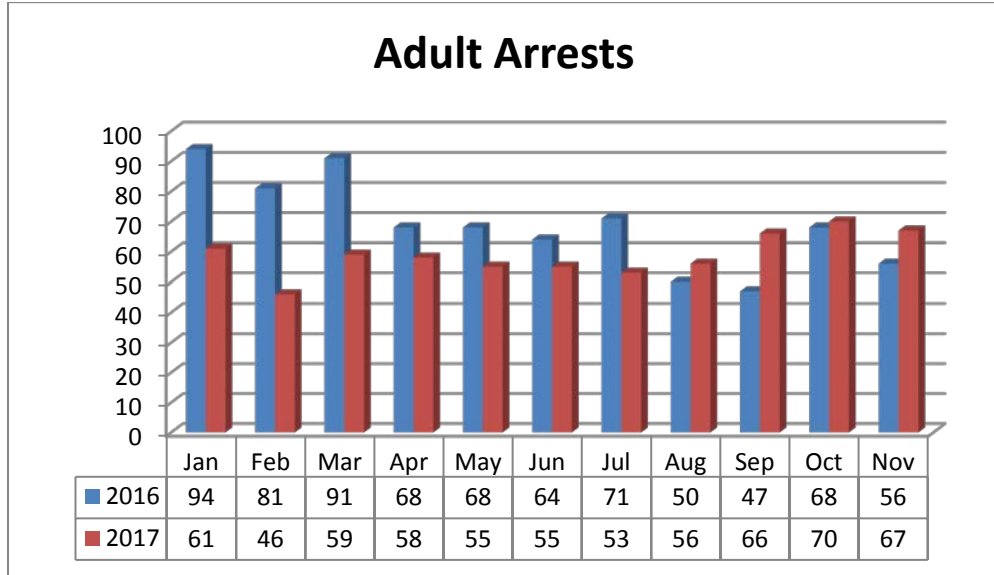

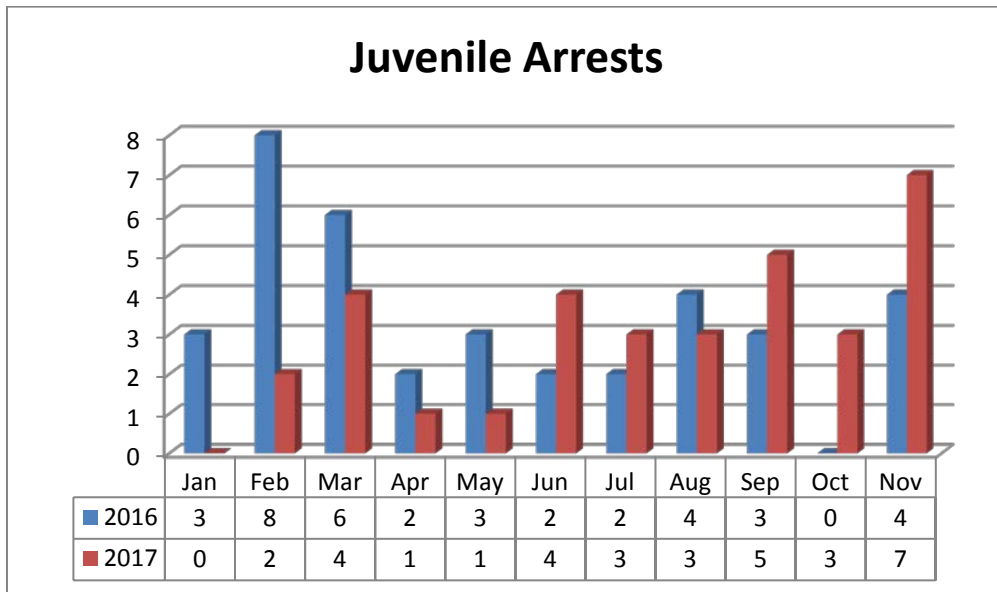

Rape: In District 1 on the 6400 block of Vallejo St., a sexual assault occurred in October, but was reported this month. The suspect is known to the victim.

Robbery: In District 3 at 65th/Christie Ave., a strong-arm robbery occurred. LOSS: A purse and cell phone. Suspects: (2) Male adults. At 6350 Christie Ave., a strong-arm robbery occurred. LOSS: Cell phone. Suspects: (3) Male juveniles. In District 5 in front of 5674 Bay St., a strong-arm robbery occurred. Loss: \$25 cash. Suspects: (3) Male juveniles. At UNIGLO 5606 Bay St., a male shoplifter used force to steal merchandise. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. At Sephora, 5626 Bay St., a male shoplifter stole perfume and exited the store. Loss Prevention contacted the suspect who pulled a knife and made threats. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. The loss was recovered. At It's Sugar 5624 Bay St., a female shoplifter took merchandise by force and exited the store. In front of H & M, 5630 Bay St., (4) male suspects attempted to rob another male of his cell phone. No loss. In District 6 on the 1500 block of Park Ave., a strong-arm robbery occurred. LOSS: Tote bag containing an iPad, and fanny pack. (Tote bag recovered near the area, however the iPad was missing.) Suspects: (2) Male juveniles.

In District 9 on the 3800 block of Emery St., (at the food truck) an armed robbery occurred. LOSS: None. Suspect: Male wearing a mask and armed with a gun. The suspect fled the area. **At Starbucks, 3839 Emery St.,** a strongarm robbery occurred. LOSS: Laptop. Suspects: (2) Male juveniles. **In front of Pak n Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave.,** a strong-arm robbery occurred. LOSS: Cell phone. Suspects: (3) Males.

Aggravated Assault: In District 6 at the Broken Rack, 5768 Peladeau St., a fight between two men resulted in one man hitting the other man with a pool cue. EPD arrested one person shortly thereafter.

Commercial Burglary: In District 3 at 6301 Shellmound St., (construction site) an unknown suspect burglarized two tool boxes and stole multiple power tools. **In District 6 at 1550 Park Ave.,** POE: Rear roll up door and ground level windows – Pried open. LOSS: Laptop, iPad (recovered), a key chain (recovered), a green cup (recovered), a first aid kit (recovered), coffee mate creamer (recovered), Neste café coffee (recovered). EPD arrested a female suspect shortly thereafter.

Residential Burglary: In District 6 in the 1400 block of Park Ave., an unknown suspect stole two bicycles from the bicycle rack located in an apartment garage. **In the 1400 block of Park Ave.,** another bicycle was stolen from the bicycle rack located in an apartment garage. **In District 8 in the 1400 block of 45th St.,** an attempted burglary occurred. An unknown suspect attempted to pry open the door to the storage room where bicycles are kept.
