

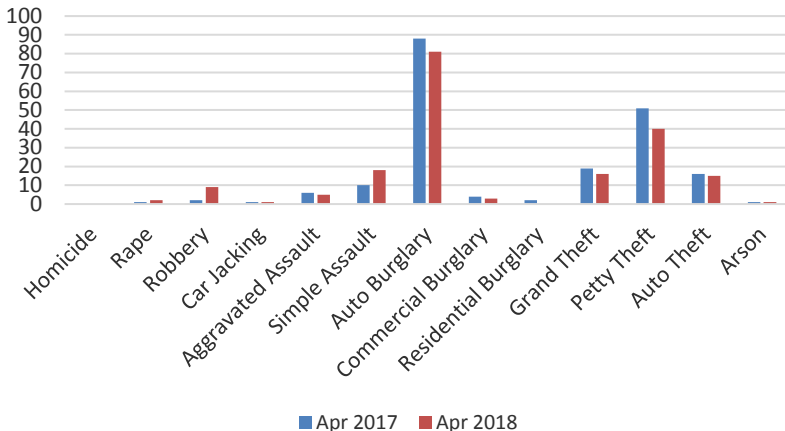

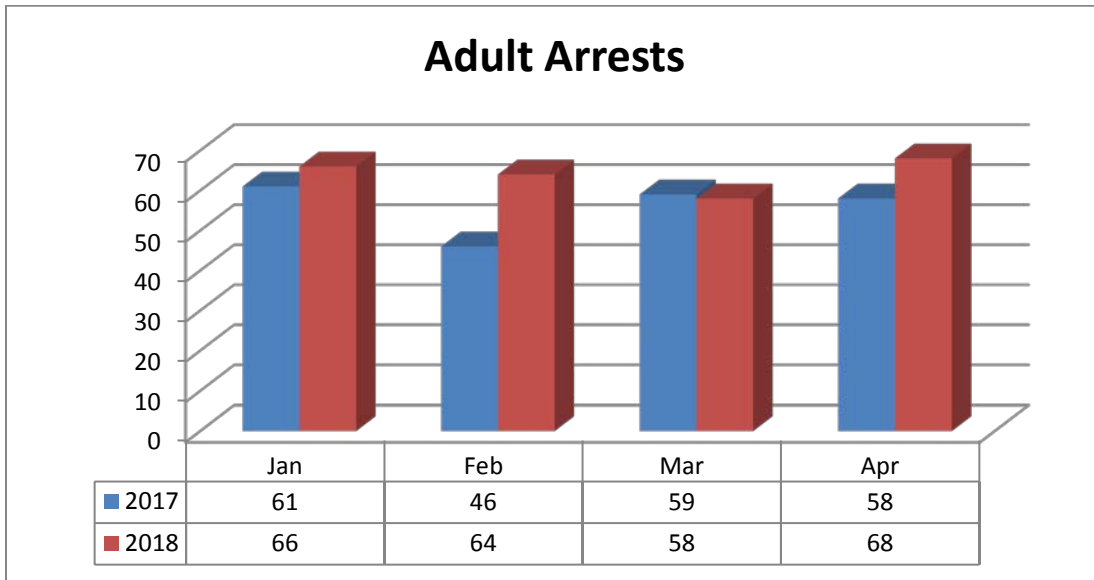

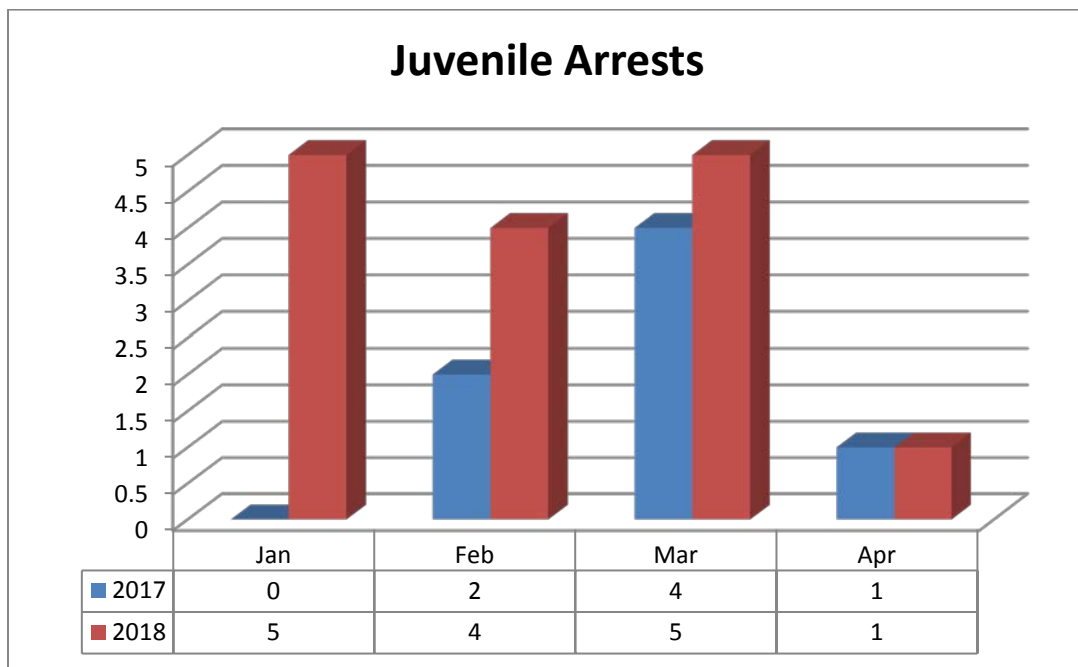

Rape: In District 2 on the 6200 block of Doyle St., a female reported being raped during the years 1991 and 1993 by a known suspect. On the 1500 block of Powell St., a female juvenile reported being raped by her boyfriend. The incident occurred in February 2018.

Car Jacking: In District 7 near the Oaks Club, 4097 San Pablo Ave., a male victim was car jacked and robbed at gunpoint. The victim located his vehicle in Oakland. LOSS: Cell phone, I.D. and \$200 cash.

Robbery: In District 3 on the 6401 block of Shellmound St., a robbery at gunpoint occurred. LOSS: Cash, 1oz of Marijuana, and car keys. The keys were recovered at the scene. Suspect: Male, 5'6", 170 lbs., wearing a black hooded sweater. At 64XX Shellmound St., inside the elevator, a robbery at gunpoint occurred. A male suspect was already inside the elevator when the female entered. The suspect demanded the victim's property. LOSS: Purse, \$2500, iPhone, and poker chips. Suspect: Male, 6'0", thin build, wearing dark clothing. In District 7 on the 4101 block of San Pablo Ave., a male approached two females at knifepoint and demanded their purses. Suspect: Male, 6'0", bald, with a large build. LOSS: (2) Purses and (2) cell phones. EPD recovered one cell phone discarded on the sidewalk. In District 9 at Ulta, 3839 Emery St., #200 two female shoplifters used forced against a security officer to steal merchandise. LOSS: Chanel Perfume.

Near Pak n Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave., a female was attacked by a group of individuals who took her coin purse containing \$100. **On the 3889 block of San Pablo near Pak n Save,** during traffic congestion a male exited his vehicle accusing another motorist of hitting his vehicle. The male demanded the motorist's property for the damages. The male then reached inside the motorist's vehicle, took his cell phone by force, and left the area. **At Nordstrom Rack, 3839 Emery St., #100** a shoplifter took merchandise by force against a loss prevention officer. LOSS: (7) Purses. Suspect: Male, mid 30s, 5'11", 170 lbs., wearing a black beanie and a gray sweat suit. **Near Nordstrom Rack, 3839 Emery St.,** (3) adult males pushed a male transient up against a wall and robbed him of his personal belongings. LOSS: A purple bag containing medication and \$15.00 cash. **In District 10 at Target, 1555 40th St.** a female shoplifter used force against a loss prevention officer to steal merchandise. EPD arrested the female shortly thereafter.

Aggravated Assault: In District 7 on the 1266 block of 45th St., an unprovoked attack occurred. A male suspect threw a pair of scissors at two men and then punched one of the men on his face. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. **In District 8 on the 4000 block of San Pablo Ave.,** a male suspect punched another male on the face causing serious injury. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. **In District 9 in the parking lot of Home Depot, 3838 Hollis St.,** a shooting occurred, in which two people were injured.

Commercial Burglary: In District 6 at 1512 Park Ave., POE: Front window – Smashed. LOSS: A DJI Phantom 4 drone, a DJI Phantom battery, carrying case, and an SD 64GB card. **In District 7 at CVS Pharmacy, 4349 San Pablo Ave.,** a known male shoplifter filled empty tote bags with allergy medicine and then forced open a display case. The suspect attempted to leave the store with the loss, but was stopped and arrested by EPD. The loss was recovered. **At the ECCL – GYM/POOL, 1170 47th St.,** in the men's locker room an unknown suspect forced open a locker and stole a back pack containing a wallet, cash and other personal items.

Auto Theft: (15) Vehicles were stolen to include (1) motorcycle and (3) attempted thefts. (6) Vehicles were recovered intact, and (6) Vehicles were recovered with damages. Various makes/models were stolen.
