

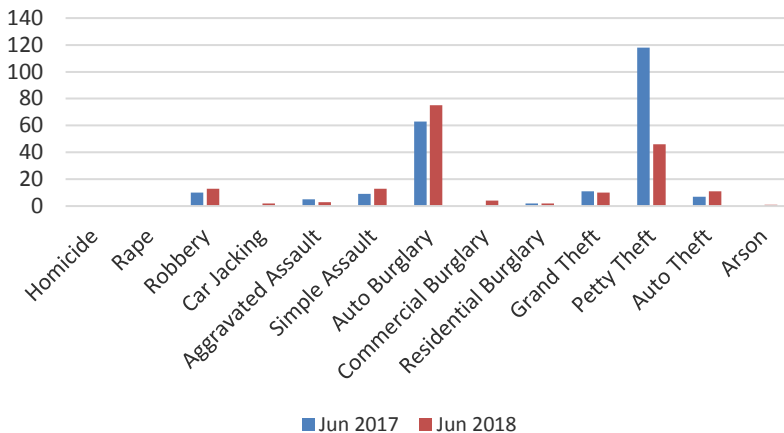

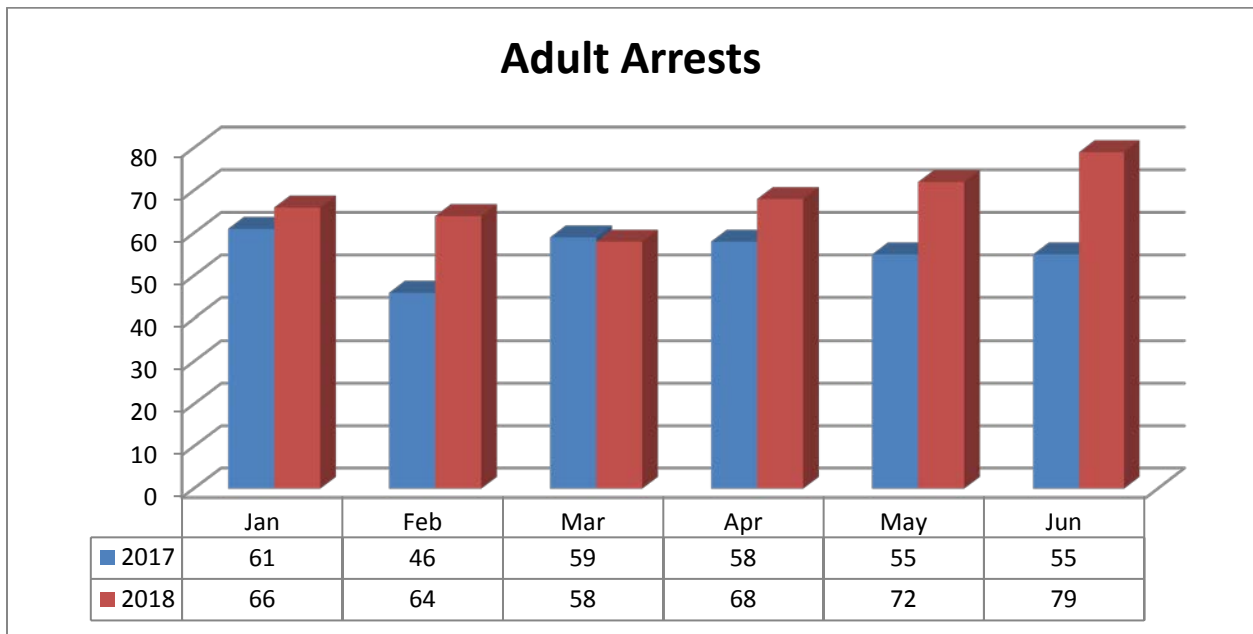

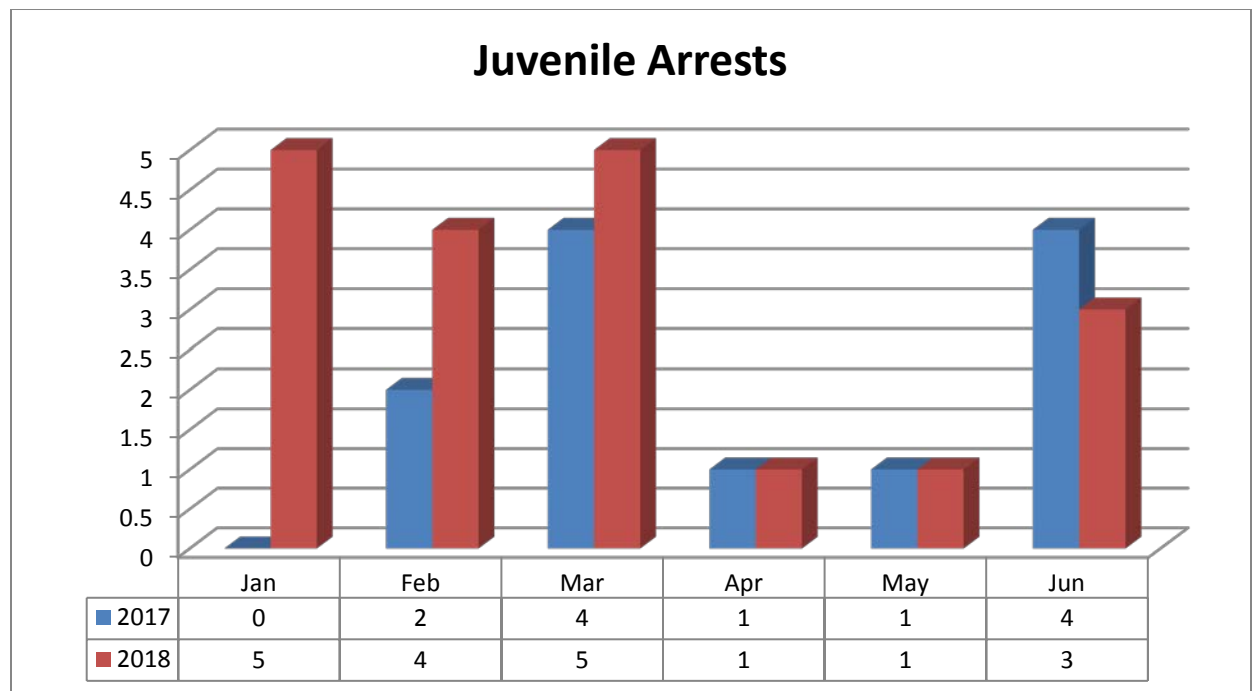

Robbery: In District 2 at Subway, 6472 Hollis St., #109, a male suspect raised his jacket exposing a gun in his waistband, while demanding cash from the register. LOSS: \$146.00 cash. S: Male, 35-40 years, clean shaven, wearing a black and blue beanie, and black jacket and jeans. In District 4 at Bay Super Shell, 1800 Powell St., a male purchased a cigar as a ruse to grab money from the register. LOSS: \$150 cash. Suspect: Male, 28-30 years old, 6'5", medium build with a short beard. The suspect was wearing a black hooded sweater and black jeans. In District 5 at Ross Dress for Less, 5733 Christie Ave., a male shoplifter stole merchandise from the store and threatened the manager with a knife. LOSS/Recovered: (3) Michael Kors purses. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. At Burger King (Parking lot), 5701 Christie Ave., a group of male juveniles robbed a 60-year-old male of his hat and glasses. In District 6 at 4230 Hubbard St., two male juveniles robbed a male adult of his cell phone and wallet. The victim recovered his cell phone shortly afterwards. In District 7 in front of the Oaks Card Club, 4097 San Pablo Ave., an Oaks Club patron was robbed at gunpoint while in his vehicle stopped at the signal light. LOSS: Wallet containing \$202 cash and identification. Suspect: Male, heavy set, wearing a ski mask, a Raider's Jacket, and blue jeans.

In front of 4701 Doyle St., two males, late teens to early 20s, robbed another male at gunpoint. LOSS: Wallet. **On the 1100 block of 53rd St.**, two males struck another male on the back of the head knocking the victim to the ground. The suspects then struck the victim multiple times on the head and body and fled with the loss. LOSS: Backpack and wallet. **In District 8 in front of the Emeryville Senior Center 4321 Salem St.**, two male juveniles robbed another male juvenile. LOSS: \$6 Cash, a cell phone, and his shoes. The shoes were recovered and returned to the victim. **In District 9 at ULTA 3839 Emery St., #200**, two male shoplifters attempted to take merchandise by force. LOSS/Recovered: Fragrances. **At Home Depot, 3838 Hollis St.**, an attempted robbery occurred. A male threatened another male acquaintance with a machete while demanding cash. There was no loss. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. **At Pak n Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave.**, a male shoplifter stole a pack of turkey jerky at knife point and fled the store.

Car Jacking: In District 5 at the intersection of Christie Ave & Shellmound St., a male juvenile stole a vehicle from another male and fled the area. An EPD officer was in the area and stopped the vehicle. A juvenile and an adult were arrested. The vehicle was returned to the owner. The victim met with the individuals to sell the vehicle. **At the Bay Street Mall, in the metered parking lot behind the Apple store**, two males carjacked a female and fled the area. OPD recovered the vehicle the following day.

Aggravated Assault: In District 5 at Bay St. & Brunswig Ln, a road rage incident resulted in a motorist pepper spraying another motorist. **In District 9 at Pak N Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave.**, a male patron punched two employees in the face for no apparent reason. One of the employees sustained an injury requiring stitches. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. **In District 10 in the parking lot of Panera Bread, 1525 40th St.**, a road rage incident between a pedestrian and motorist resulted in the motorist striking the pedestrian with a steering wheel lock. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter.

Commercial Burglary: In District 2 at Los Moles, 1320 65th St., POE: Door – Pried. LOSS: Unknown amount of cash. Suspect: Unknown. **At Emery Go Round, 1601 63rd St., #D** POE: No force. LOSS: A work cell phone. Suspect: Unknown. **At KYU Express, 6485 Hollis St.**, POE: Front door – Window smash. LOSS: \$3 dollars. Suspect: Male. **In District 3 at Clausen Engineering, 1727 64th St.**, POE: Door – Pried. LOSS: None. Suspect: Male wearing a blue shirt and black vest.

Residential Burglary: In District 6 at 14XX 45th St., #XX, POE: Window. LOSS: None. A male suspect was leaning inside the window, however the resident, who was inside of the apartment, deterred the suspect from entering. The suspect fled the area on a light blue mountain bike. **In District 9 at 13XX 40th St.**, POE: Garage. LOSS: (2) Bicycles. Suspect: Unknown.

Auto Theft: (11) Vehicles were stolen this month, (6) of which were recovered intact, (2) vehicles were damaged, (1) vehicle was damaged and stripped, and (1) motorcycle is still outstanding. Various makes were stolen, however pickup trucks were popular.
