

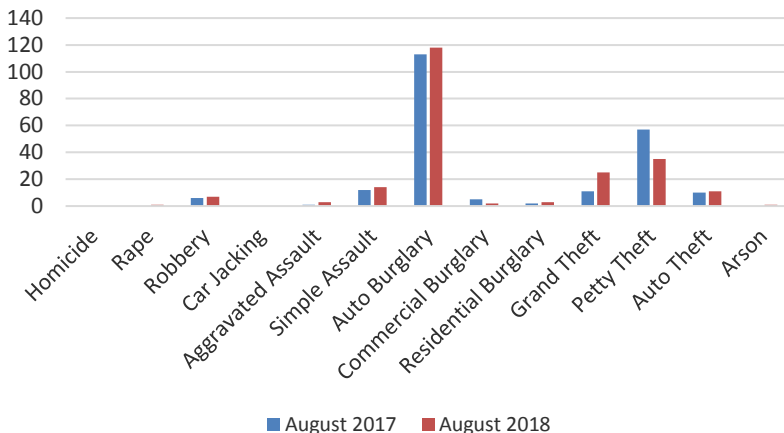

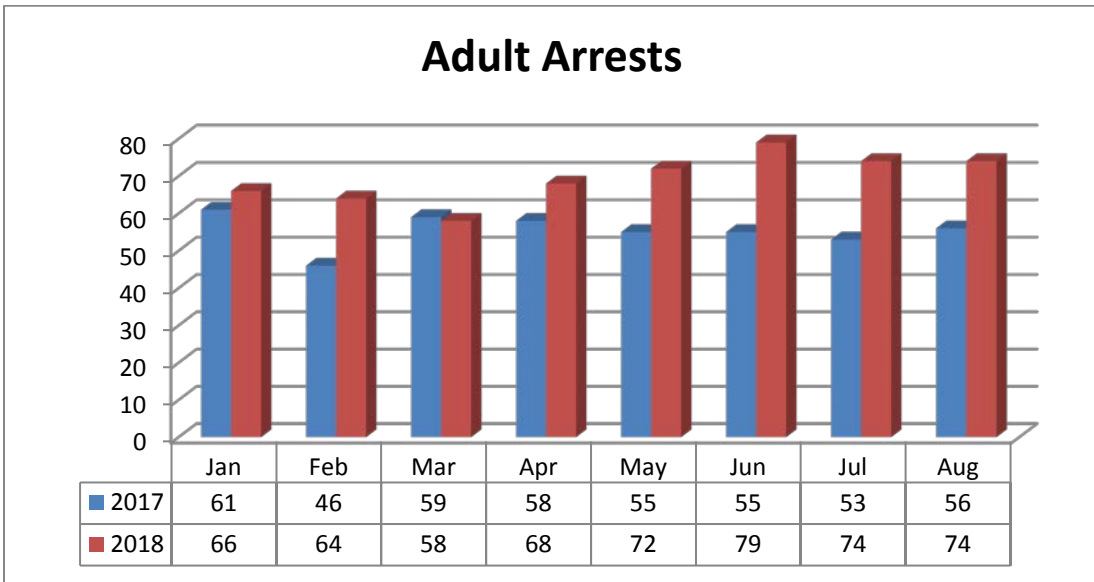

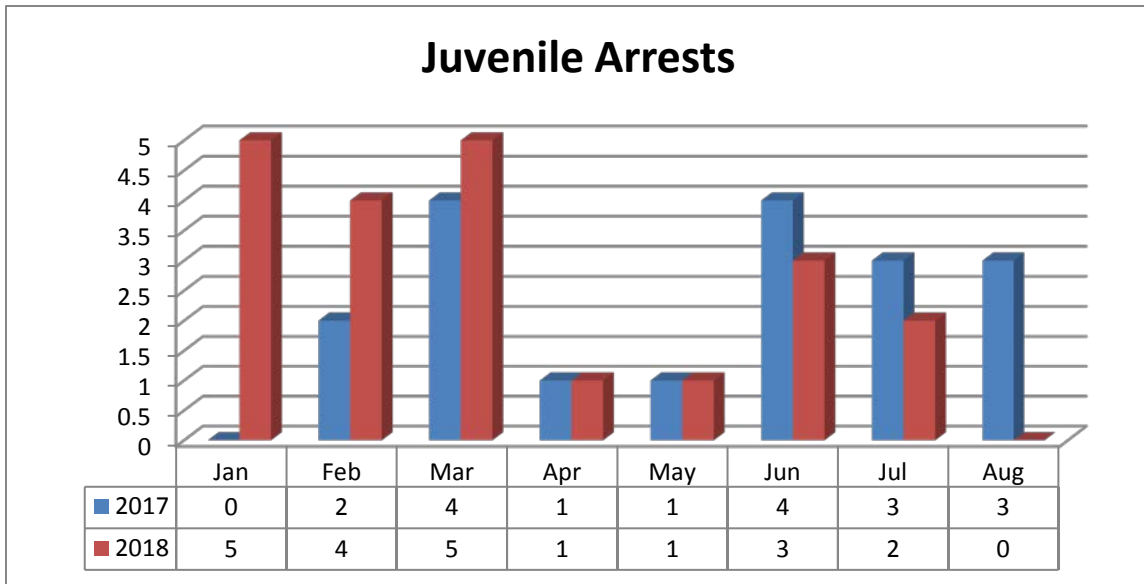

Rape: In District 4 at the Hilton Garden Inn, a sexual assault occurred to a female during a party.

Robbery: In District 2 at Hollis St & 62nd St., a female victim, walking to work, was approached by another female who demanded the victim's property. LOSS: A cell phone, a Laptop, and a backpack. Suspect: Female adult, tall, wearing a red shirt and black pants. The suspect entered a black SUV driven by an unknown accomplice. At 64th & Hollis St., four male suspects exited a vehicle, approached two male victims and robbed them of their belongings. Suspects: Males, late teens, early 20s. Suspect Vehicle: Maroon midsize 4D sedan with large dents along the passenger side doors. LOSS: A cell phone, a wallet, a gray bag, a Kindle tablet, and a vest. In District 5 at Burger King, 5701 Christie Ave., a male suspect ordered food and payed as a ruse to open the register. Once the register was open, the suspect jumped the counter and removed the cash. Suspect: Male wearing a black beanie, black hoodie, and blue jeans. LOSS: \$140 cash. In front of West Elm, 5602 Bay St., a females' boyfriend robbed her of her make up recently purchased from the Mac Store. The couple were involved in a domestic dispute earlier that morning in Oakland. In District 7 at Wing Stop 4133 San Pablo Ave., a male suspect robbed the business. Suspect: Male, late 30s, 6'0", wearing a dark colored baseball hat, and white shirt. LOSS: \$100.

In District 8 in front of 1096 Yerba Buena, three male teenagers robbed another male of his cell phone. The teens fled on foot towards Oakland. **In District 9 at Panda Express, 1151 40th St.**, a male suspect reached into the open register and grabbed a hand full of cash. Suspect: Male, approximately 6'0", mid 30s, with a beard, wearing a black sweater with a red stripe on the front and black pants. LOSS: \$306.

Aggravated Assault: In District 3 in the area of the Hyatt House, 5800 Shellmound St., a male suspect riding a bicycle collided into a family pushing their baby in a stroller. An altercation occurred between the male half and the suspect. The suspect then threw a rock at the family striking the female half on her leg. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter.

Commercial Burglary: In District 3 at EMME Apartments, 63XX Christie Ave., (Maintenance room) An unknown suspect entered the maintenance room with a key and stole a cordless drill. The drill was recovered outside. **In District 8 at DW Barber Shop, 3996 San Pablo Ave.**, POE: Door – Window smashed. LOSS: Hair clippers and gas can.

Residential Burglary: In District 3 at 63XX Christie Ave., POE: Door – Pried. LOSS: A laptop and checkbook. **In District 4 at X Captain Drive**, POE: Door – Pried. LOSS: Jewelry, purses, and foreign currency. **In District 7 at 1XX Temescal Cir.**, POE: Unknown. LOSS: A Hermes Birkin Thalassa purse, a Gucci tote bag, a pair of Chanel sunglasses, and jewelry.

Arson: In District 8 at 1000 48th St, Temescal Creek Park, an unknown suspect set fire to bedding material.

Auto Theft: (11) Vehicles were stolen including one motorcycle. (5) Vehicles were recovered intact, (1) vehicle was damaged and stripped, and (5) vehicles remain outstanding. Various Makes/models were stolen.
