

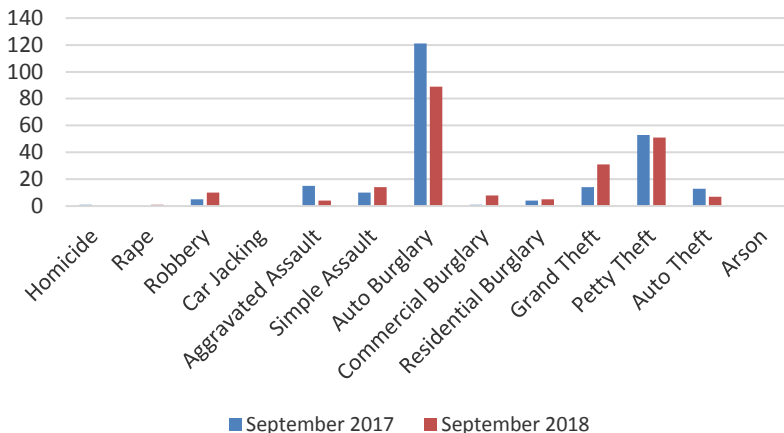

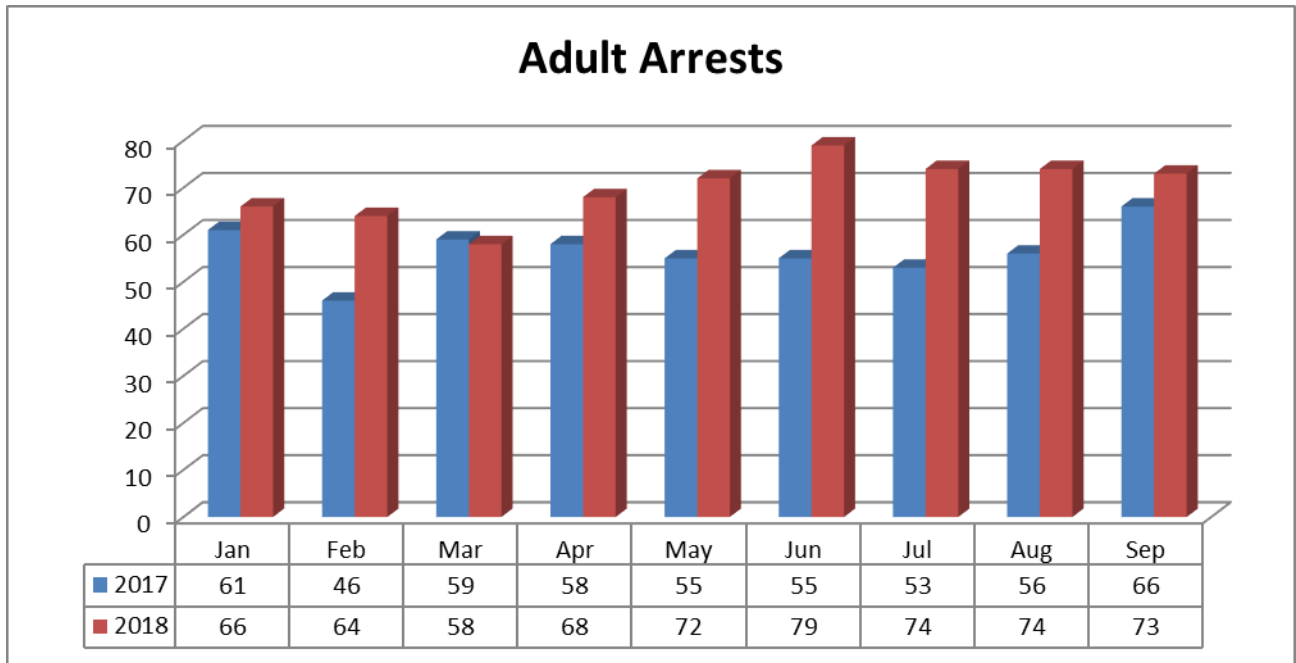

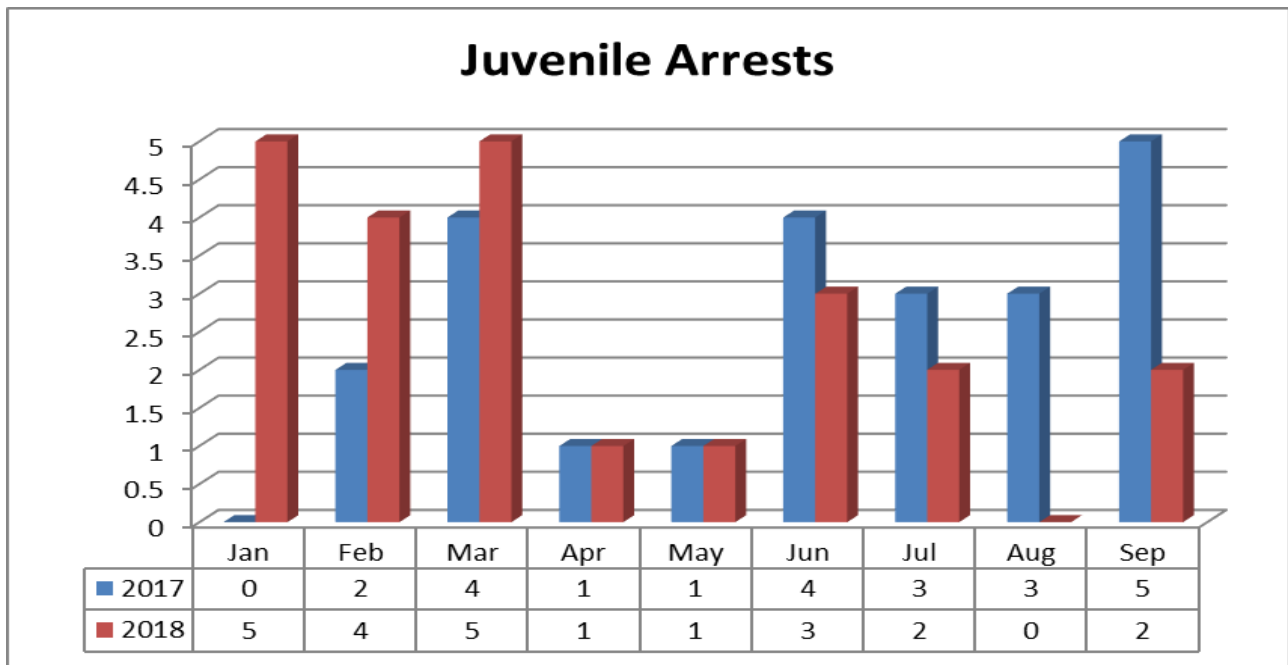

Rape: In District 9 at 13XX 40th St., a female was raped by her boyfriend.

Robbery: In District 3 at 64XX Shellmound St., domestic violence incident occurred in which, a female forced her way into her girlfriend's apartment, and a struggle ensued. LOSS/Recovered: Cell phone. EPD arrested the female shortly thereafter. In District 4 at the Emeryville Marina, 3310 Powell St., a strongarm robbery occurred. LOSS: Backpack containing cameras and camera equipment. SUSPECT: Male, late 20s, with a full beard wearing a gray hoodie and dark jeans. At the Hilton Garden Inn parking lot area, 1800 Powell St., a strongarm robbery occurred. LOSS: Cell phone. SUSPECT: Male, 27-30 years old. In District 5 at the Apple Store, 5640 Bay St., LOSS: Multiple cellphones and laptops. Suspects: 5-6 males wearing hoodies. At Marshall's 5795 Christie Ave., a male suspect concealed shoes underneath a jacket and left the store without paying. Loss Prevention confronted the suspect, however the suspect fled the area. Suspect: Male. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Jaguar, no further description. In District 7 on the 4501 block of San Pablo Ave., a strongarm robbery occurred. A male suspect snatched a females' cell phone and miscellaneous cards from the females' hands. The suspect fled to vehicle driven by a female and left the area. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Nissan sedan, no further description.

Aggravated Assault: In District 6 at 40th & Hubbard Streets, a Domestic Violence incident resulted in a man hitting a female on the head with a hatchet.
