

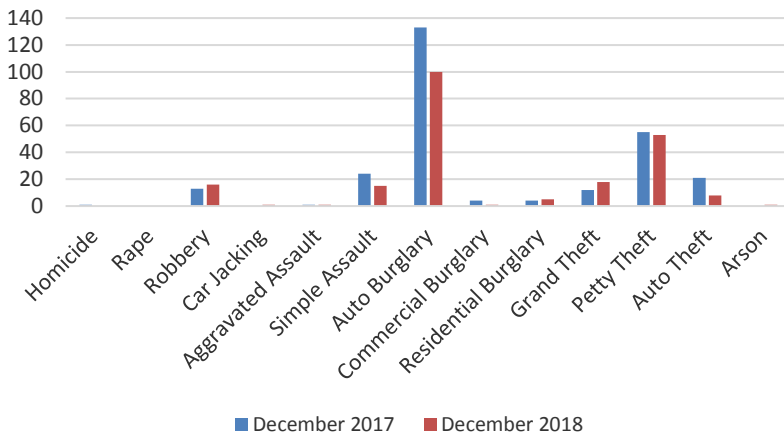

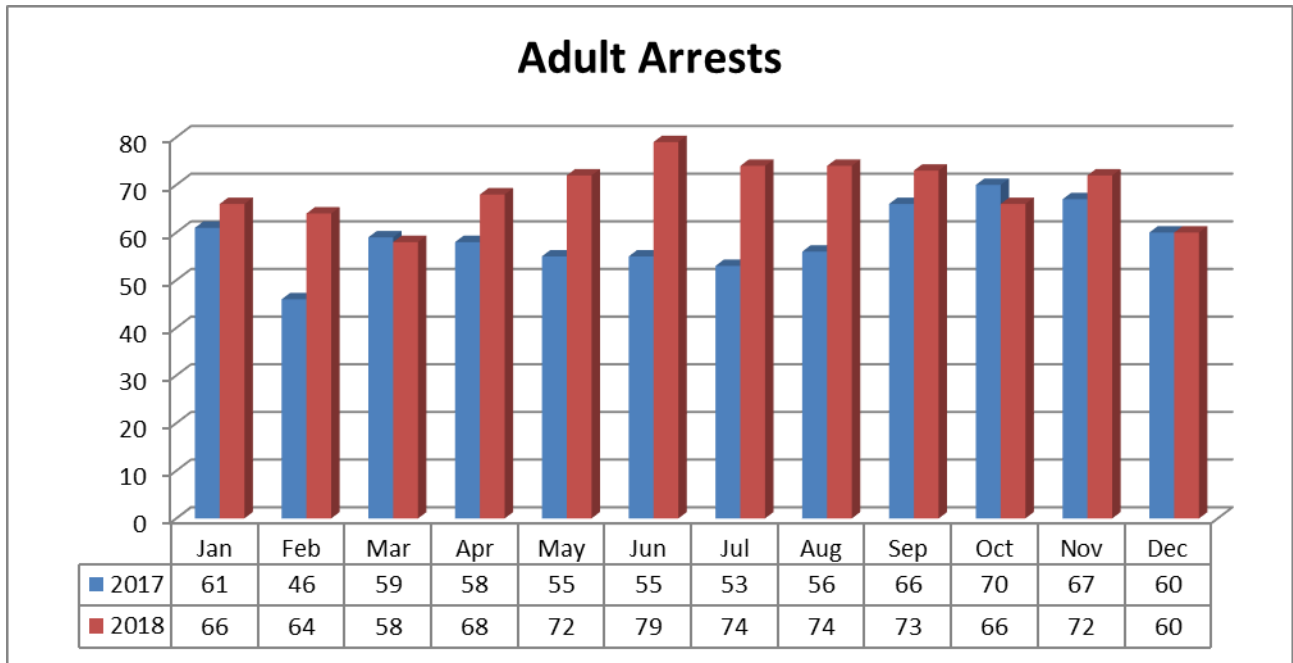

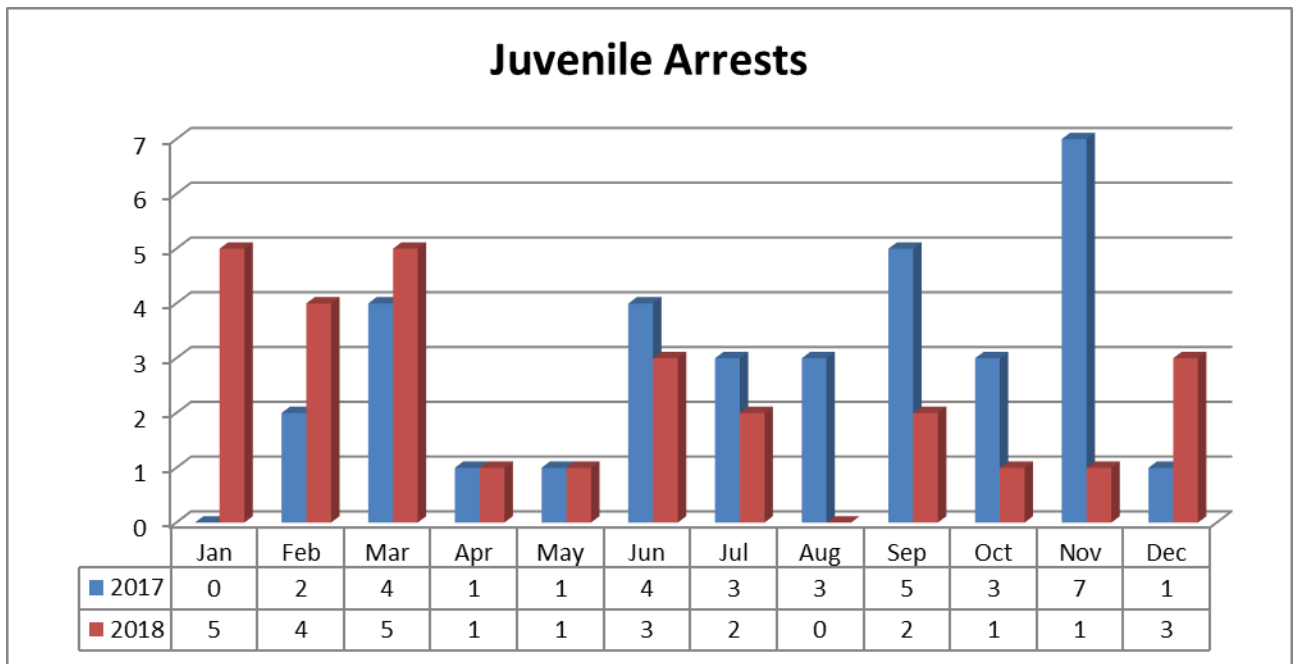

Robbery: In District 1 on the 1270 block of 62nd St., a strongarm robbery occurred. LOSS: Wallet, keys, and cell phone. SUSPECTS: #1 male, 20-25 years old, 6'0", 180 lbs., with short hair, wearing a black sweatshirt and dark pants. #2 Male, 20-25 years old, shorter than suspect #1, stocky build, wearing a black sweatshirt. **In District 5 at Carter's, 5731 Christie Ave.,** two female shoplifters used force to steal merchandise. One of the suspects threatened to spray the employee with mace. Both suspects fled down the alleyway. **In District 5 at Shellmound St., & Christie Ave.,** a group of juveniles attacked a 19-year-old male and attempted to take his shoes. LOSS: (1) Shoe. The juveniles fled the area. **In front of Old Navy, 5625 Bay St.,** a male suspect grabbed a shopping bag from a male adult's hand and fled. LOSS: (2) Gold iPhones. Suspects: (3) Male juveniles, one wearing a black hoodie, and the others wearing gray hoodies. **In front of 5601 Bay Street (Bay Street Mall),** (3) Female juveniles attacked another female juvenile and robbed her of her cell phone. The juveniles were acquaintances. **In District 6 at Hollis St & Park Ave.,** (3) Male juveniles attacked a male adult and took his cell phone. As the suspects fled the area, one of the suspects dropped the phone. The victim recovered his phone. Shortly after this incident, the same juveniles robbed another male adult of his backpack and fled the area. **At Hollis St. & 45th St.,** a male suspect told a male victim (17 years old) that he had a gun and demanded the victim's wallet. The victim complied, and the suspect fled the area.

In District 7 at CVS Pharmacy, 4349 San Pablo Ave., a robbery at gunpoint occurred. A male suspect displayed a gun in his waistband and then pointed the gun at the clerk, while demanding cash from the cash register. The suspect removed cash from the register and fled the area. EPD later arrested the suspect who was also responsible for the Gamestop robbery mentioned below. **At Black and White Market, 4051 San Pablo Ave.,** a strongarm robbery occurred. LOSS: (1) Pack of cigarettes. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. **In District 8 on the 1024 block of 47th St.,** a male suspect pistol whipped a male victim and took the victim's wallet. SUSPECT: Male, 30-35 years old. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Older model pickup truck, brown in color, driven by another male suspect. **At 7-Eleven, 4000 San Pablo Ave.,** a transient attempted to take hats and scarfs, however a struggled ensued between the suspect and store employee. The merchandise and the employee's cell phone dropped to the floor. The suspect grabbed the cell phone and fled the area. LOSS: Employee's cell phone. **In District 9 near Pak n Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave.,** a domestic violence incident resulted in an ex-boyfriend taking his ex-girlfriend's bags of groceries and fanny pack by force. **In the parking lot in front of Sally's Beauty, 3839 Emery St.,** (3) Suspects robbed a patron at gunpoint. SUSPECTS: #1 Armed with a semi-auto handgun, male, 5'9", 18-25 years old, wearing a black mask and black hoodie, white jeans, and black Air Jordans. #2 Armed with a semi-auto handgun, male, 5'7", 180 lbs., wearing a black mask, a black hoodie, dark blue jeans, and white Nike Air Force 1. #3 Male with a dark complexion. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Kia Optima, white. LOSS: \$1500 cash and (2) prescription bottles of Oxycodone. **At Gamestop, 3980 Hollis St.,** a robbery at gunpoint occurred. LOSS/RECOVERED: \$1535 cash. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. (Same suspect responsible for the CVS Pharmacy robbery mentioned above). **In District 10 at Target, 1555 40th St.,** a female juvenile shoplifter took merchandise by force. LOSS/RECOVERED: Underwear. EPD arrested the juvenile shortly thereafter. **Target parking lot, 1555 40th St.,** (2) Male suspects on electric scooters took a patron's keys by force. A male witness intervened and recovered the keys. However, the suspect that took the keys punched the witness on the back of the head causing a minor injury. Both suspects fled the area.

Aggravated Assault: In District 3 on the 5800 block of Shellmound St., a domestic violence incident between boyfriends resulted in one male being sprayed in the face with mace. EPD arrested the other male shortly thereafter.

Commercial Burglary: In District 7 at ECCL – Emery High School, 1100 47th St., POE: Cafeteria door. LOSS: A laptop computer.

Residential Burglary: In District 3 at 64XX Christie Ave., POE: Front door – Pried open. LOSS: A laptop, an iPad, and a bag containing Christmas gifts. **At 64XX Christie Ave.,** POE: Front door – Pried open. LOSS: (3) Laptops, and a portable Beats speaker. **In District 4 at X Captain Dr.,** POE: Front door – Pried open. LOSS: Jewelry, a computer and video game switch. **In District 7 at 55XX Doyle St.,** POE: Storage locker – Lock cut. LOSS: Bicycle. **In District 9 at 13XX 40th St.,** several mailboxes were burglarized, and mail was stolen.

Auto Theft: (8) Vehicles were stolen, (4) of which were recovered with damages, (3) vehicles were recovered intact, and (1) vehicles was damaged and stripped.
