1. Meeting Called to Order at 5:33 p.m.
2. Roll Call: All members present except members Lovett-Harris and Kain. A round of introductions were made.
3. Public Comment on Items Not on the Agenda: None
4. Information Items:
  - 4.1 Review of Brown Act: City Attorney, Michael Guina provided an informational presentation of the Brown Act. Members of the committee asked questions that were answered by City Attorney Guina.
  - 4.2 Review of the City's Planning Process: Senior Planner, Miroo Desai provided an informational presentation of the City's Planning process. Members of the committee asked questions that were answered by Senior Planner Desai.

5. Action Items

- 5.1 Reconsideration of Actions Taken at July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 BPAC meeting regarding bicycle, pedestrian and vehicular access to and through the proposed Onni project:

**BPAC Moved/Seconded/Passed (M/S/P)**, McCamy/Scheuerman/7-0-0-2-0, that bikes be allowed in all elevators on the Onni site and at least one elevator be built large enough in the residential building to accommodate a cargo bicycle, built 8 feet in depth, as a City Condition of Approval.

**BPAC M/S/P**, Scheuerman/Birch/7-0-0-2-0 that the Onni project provide secure bike room in both the commercial and the residential building and lockers with included electrical outlets in the lockers and the bike room(s).

**BPAC M/S/P**, McCamy/Carnes/7-0-0-2-0, that motor vehicles be moved to the periphery and the project be re-oriented around bicyclist and pedestrian space and that safe ingress for bikes and pedestrians be provided at or near the center driveway with connectivity to all the important destinations of the project and bike and pedestrian paths to and from the surrounding area.

**BPAC M/S/P**, Scheuerman/Birch/7-0-0-2-0, to recommend to City Council that an amendment be made to the Pedestrian Bicycle Plan and the General Plan that the desire path in the green space between the I-80 freeway on-ramp and Denny's be added.

**BPAC M/S/P**, McCamy/Birch/7-0-0-2-0 that the Onni project receive bonus points from the City for acquiring an easement for bike and ped path on the westside of Denny's where there is currently a desire path.

**BPAC M/S/P**, Harr/Carnes/7-0-0-2-0, that the Onni project be designed such that there is easy and continuous access, to the existing desire path on the west side of Denny's property from and through the Onni project.

(The items above, originally heard on July 1<sup>st</sup>, needed to be reconsidered as they were not adequately agendized on the July 1<sup>st</sup> agenda)
