

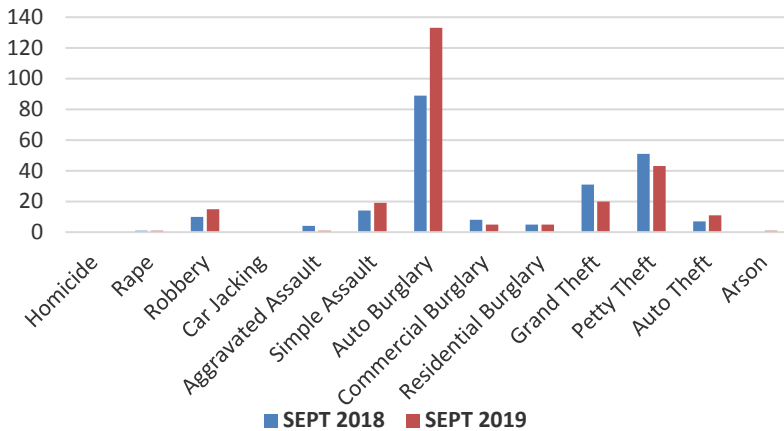

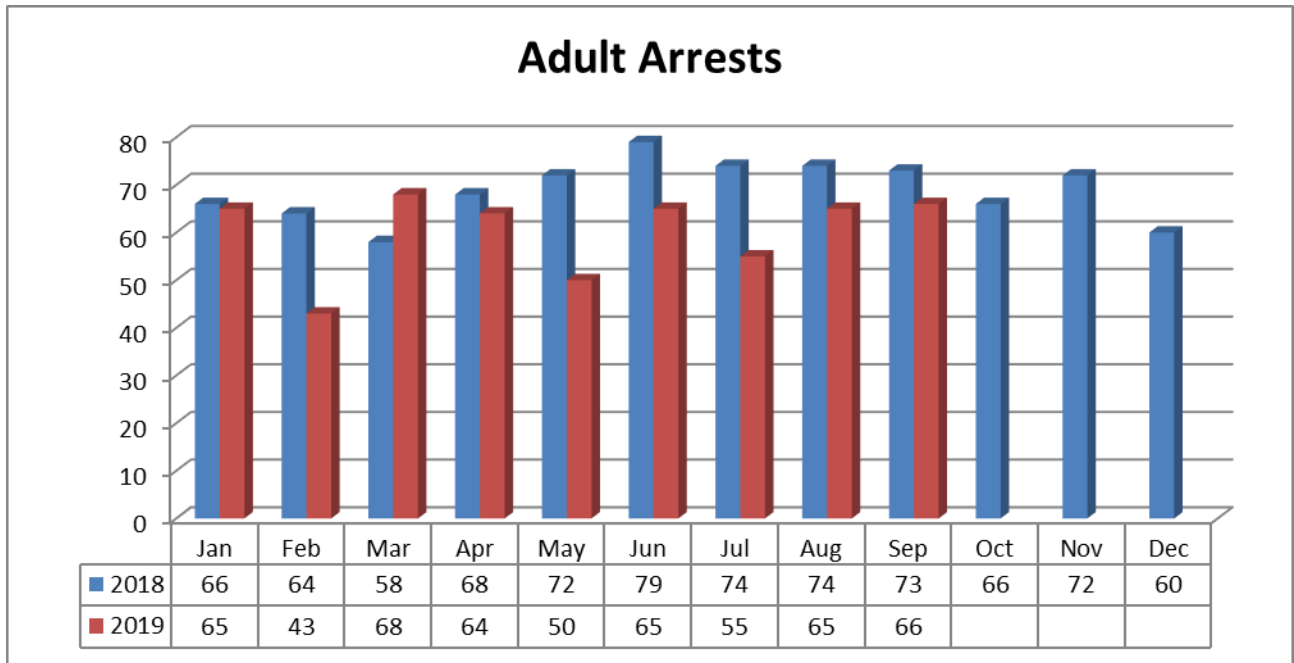

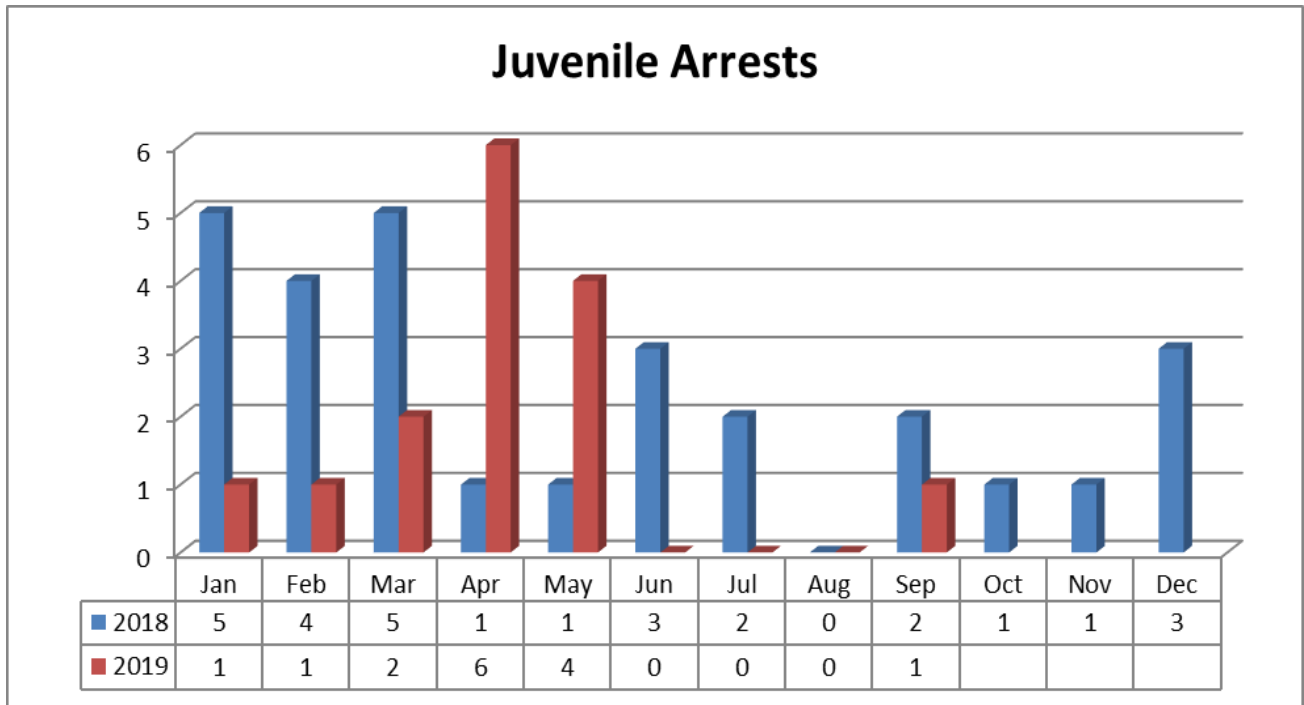

Rape: In District 9 in the rear of Pak N Sav (alley way), a rape occurred. The suspect is in custody.

Robbery: In District 3 at Peets Coffee and Tea, 5959 Shellmound St., a strongarm robbery occurred. LOSS: A laptop. SUSPECTS: (2) Males 16-20 years old. On the 6200 block of Shellmound St., a strongarm robbery occurred. LOSS: A laptop. SUSPECT: Male, late 20s – early 30s, 5'6"-5'7", wearing a red hoody and red sweat pants. In District 5 at the GAP, 5690 Bay St., two female shoplifters used force to steal merchandise. SUSPECTS: (2) Females, 16-18 years old. In front of the Apple Store, 5640 Bay St., a strongarm robbery occurred. LOSS: A Samsung S9 plus cell phone. In front of West Elm, 5602 Bay St., a strongarm robbery occurred. LOSS: A cell phone. SUSPECT: Male, 6'0", 150 lbs., wearing a black Adidas style track jacket. In front of Fuddruckers, 5614 Bay St., #232 a strongarm robbery occurred. LOSS: (2) Gold chains snatched from the victim's neck. The suspect attempted to take the victim's cell phone, however was unsuccessful. SUSPECTS: (3) Males, 14-16 years old. In front of Ross Dress for Less, 5733 Christie Ave., a strongarm robbery occurred. LOSS: Cell phone. SUSPECTS: (3) Male juveniles. The suspects fled to an awaiting vehicle. SUSPECT VEHICLE: 2015 Toyota Rav SUV gray, Carjacked from Oakland.

At the cell phone kiosk, an irate customer pointed a BB gun at an employee and took the employee's cell phone. The customer placed the cell phone on the counter prior to leaving the kiosk. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. **At Marshall's, 5795 Christie Ave.**, a male shoplifter used force to steal merchandise. SUSPECT VEHICLE: 2002 BMW 330 BLUE. **At Zumiez, 5677 Bay St.**, a female shoplifter used force to steal merchandise. The suspect was accompanied by another female who shoplifted merchandise. LOSS: (4) T-Shirts. EPD arrested both suspects shortly thereafter. **In District 7 at CVS Pharmacy, 4349 San Pablo Ave.**, a female suspect simulated a gun in her jacket pocket and demanded cash from the register. LOSS: \$188 cash. SUSPECT: Female, wearing all black clothing with blue Nike swooshes on her shoes. **In District 8 in front of Black and White Liquors, 4051 San Pablo Ave.**, four male juveniles robbed another male juvenile. The suspects claimed to have a gun. No gun seen. LOSS: A jacket, a cell phone, a clipper card, and \$13 cash. SUSPECTS: Males 14-15 years old. SUSPECT VEHICLE: 2000s Toyota Camry or Corolla, gray in color. **In District 9 at Baskin Robbins, 1199 40th St., #200**, a male suspect entered the business with a gun and demanded cash. LOSS: \$150 cash. SUSPECT: Male with a mask covering the bottom portion of his face, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, black pants, and light-colored shoes. **In District 10 in the parking lot of Panera Bread, 1525 40th St.**, a strongarm robbery occurred. LOSS: An iPhone and drivers license. SUSPECTS: (5) Males in their 20s. SUSPECT VEHICLE: 2015 Toyota RAV gray in color. (Same suspects from the Ross Dress for Less incident.) **At Target, 1555 40th St.**, a shoplifter used force to steal merchandise. LOSS: Clothing. SUSPECT: Male, wearing a black hat, dark gray shirt and dark blue jeans.

Aggravated Assault: In District 3 in at the Hyatt House, 5800 Shellmound St., a domestic violence incident occurred resulting in the male holding a female down by her throat.

Commercial Burglary: In District 2 at 6655 Hollis St., at the construction site, an unknown suspect(s) cut the outer locks off two Conex boxes. LOSS: Multiple tools. **At Glashaus Garage, 6466 Hollis St.**, POE: Unlawful entry – Front door. An unknown male suspect on a bicycle burgled the lobby mailbox. **In District 5 at the Apple Store, 5640 Bay St.**, an unknown suspect attempted to force open the doors by pressing on the doors with a stolen vehicle. **At the Apple Store, 5640 Bay St.**, a second attempted burglary occurred. A suspect attempted to smash the window with a rock while a second suspect acted as a look out. SUSPECTS: (2) Males, 16 and 18 years old. EPD arrested both suspects shortly thereafter. **At the Apple Store, 5640 Bay St.**, a third attempted burglary occurred. Three male suspects in a carjacked vehicle purposely collided with the storefront door twice.

Residential Burglary: In District 1 at 12XX 66th St., POE: Garage – No sign of forced entry. LOSS: Specialized bicycle, light blue. **In District 2 at 14XX 65th St.**, POE: Storage Unit – Lock damaged. LOSS: DJ equipment. **In District 3 at 64XX Christie Ave., #XXXX** POE: Front door – Pried. LOSS: A bicycle, a camera, and several watches including a Rolex watch. **In District 8 at 10XX 41st St., Attempt only.** POE: Door knob removed – no entry. **At 10XX 45th St., #X**, POE: Door knob damaged. LOSS: Multiple personal items.

Auto Theft: (8) Vehicles were stolen including a motorcycle, and (3) attempted thefts. (6) Vehicles were recovered, (5) of which were recovered intact, and (1) vehicle was damaged. Ford trucks were popular this month.
