PUBLIC NOTICE NOTICE OF VACANCY ON THE EMERYVILLE HOUSING COMMITTEE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a vacancy has occurred on the Emeryville Housing Committee. The City is accepting applications from interested individuals to serve on the Committee for a term through March 31, 2011.

The Emeryville Housing Committee is a 13-member standing advisory committee to the City Council comprised of two Councilmembers, Emeryville residents and local Emeryville business owners or representatives. The members of the Emeryville Housing Committee review housing policies and city housing programs, funding proposals for Redevelopment Agency-assisted projects, and generally provide advice to the full City Council on housing policy matters that affect the City. During the 2009/2010 fiscal year, the Committee will be involved in finalizing the 2009 Housing Element, reviewing proposals for the redevelopment of Agency-owned properties as affordable housing, and other housing policy and program matters. The Committee meets monthly at City Hall on the first Wednesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. Member applications are reviewed by the Housing Committee and are forwarded to the City Council for recommendation of appointment. Members are appointed by the City Council and serve three-year terms.

Interested persons are strongly encouraged to attend at least one meeting of the Housing Committee prior to making a decision to apply to the Committee so that they may learn more about the committee's current projects, function and role. Interested persons are also encouraged to contact the Committee Secretary, Amy Hiestand, in the Economic Development and Housing Department, to learn more about the Committee and find out the next meeting date, at (510) 596-4354, or ahiestand@emeryville.org.

The Emeryville City Council encourages interested residents and business persons in Emeryville to apply for appointment to the Housing Committee. Applications for this unscheduled vacancy will be accepted until the vacancy is filled, and will be considered by the Housing Committee and forwarded to the City Council for consideration.**
