

Aquatics:

- Lap swim continues to operate 7 days a week,
- Averaging 18 lap swimmer per day
- 3rd party ECCL rentals continue (Masters Swim Rental 5:30-9:30a, Piedmont Swim Team 3:30p – 5:30p)
- Swim Camps continues to operate under approved rules by the County. Camps run in 4-week sessions. Currently have about 35 children registered

- Enrollment 35

Senior Services

- Continue to do our Senior weekly check-ins (200-300) by phone tree with volunteers and staff
- Continue to do Zoom “Coffee with the Seniors” where staff can check in and seniors can see their friends and socialize.
- Our volunteers and staff continue to serve approximately 50+ seniors each week with meals (3 days M/W/F) and Mercy Brown Bag grocery food bags two times a month.
- The 8 to Go Shuttle service is operating 3 days a week to help seniors get groceries, doctor appointments and other essential services; ridership is still increasing.
- Offering 9 virtual Zoom exercise classes with approximately 100 participants (fitness, wellness, etc.)
