

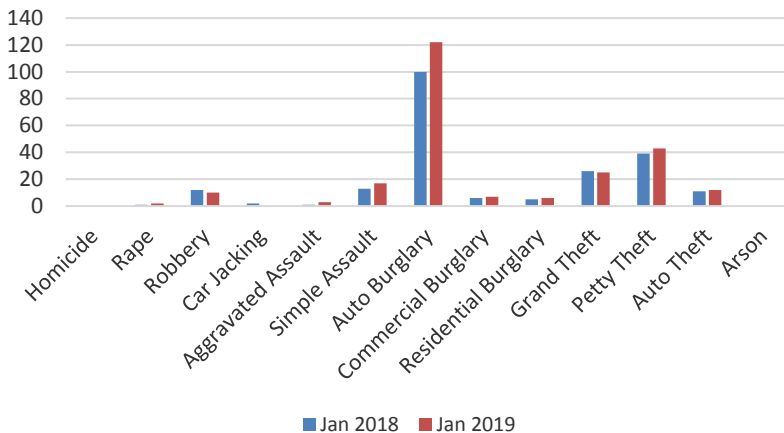

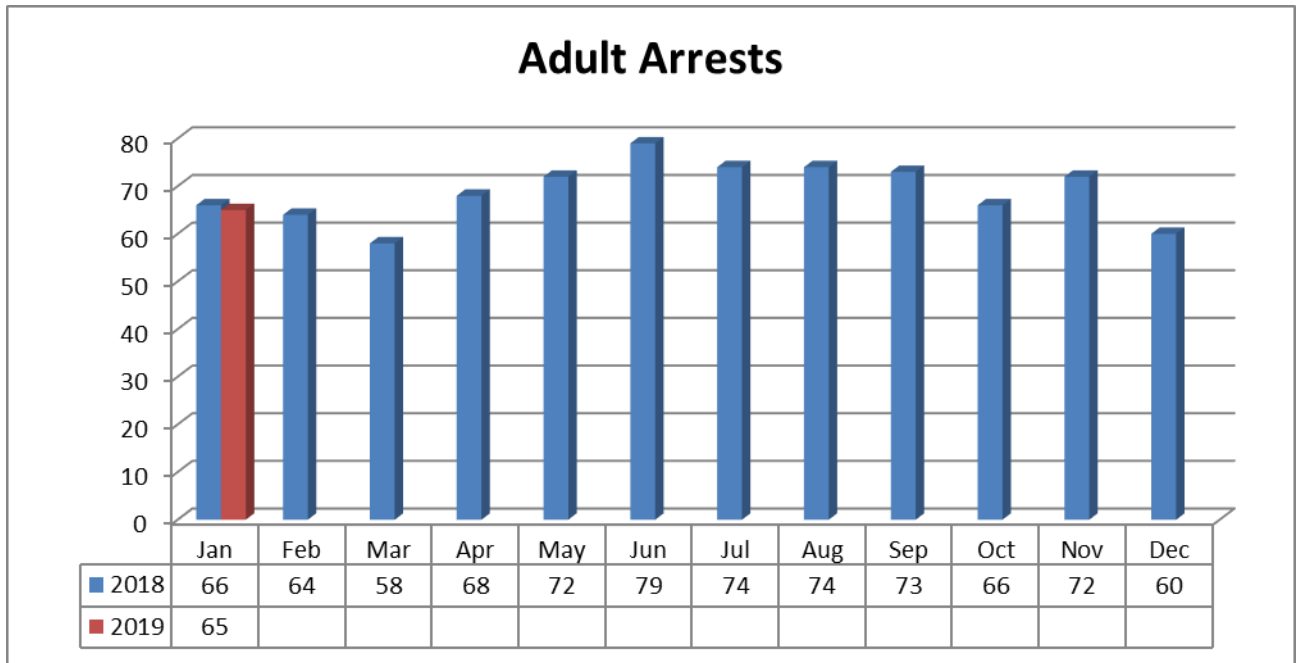

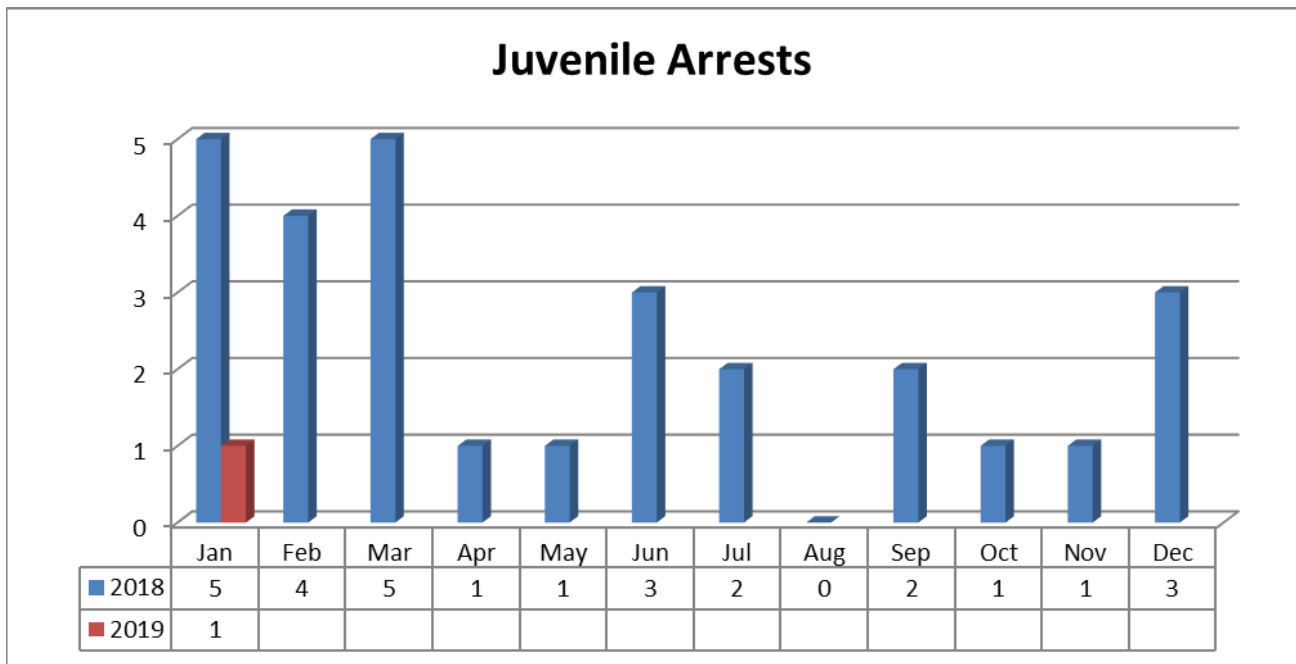

Rape: In District 3 at on the 58XX block of Christie Ave., a female was sexually assaulted by a male acquaintance. In District 7 on the 12XX block of Park Ave., a female transient alleged being raped and is uncooperative with the investigation.

Robbery: In District 2 at 62nd/Horton St., a male juvenile **attempted** to take a female's cell phone from her hand. The victim and suspect struggled over the phone until the suspect gave up and fled the area with two other male juveniles. Suspects: Males, approximately 17 years old. In District 3 at Urban Outfitters, 5903 Shellmound St., a female used force to steal clothes valued at \$1000. At Urban Outfitters, 5903 Christie Ave., a male and female used forced to steal merchandise. Part of the loss was recovered as the suspects fled the store. At Urban Outfitters, 5903 Christie Ave., a group of suspects used forced to steal merchandise. One of the suspects dropped part of the loss while fleeing from the store. Another suspect pepper sprayed the store employee and security guard. SUSPECTS: (1) male and (3) females. SUSPECT VEHICLE: HYUNDAI, BLACK IN COLOR. At Wells Fargo Bank, 5801 Christie Ave., two male suspects armed with guns forced a male to withdraw money from the ATM. LOSS: \$300. SUSPECT VEHICLE: OLDER MODEL ACURA, 2-DOOR, SILVER.

On the Amtrak Pedestrian Bridge, a male reached over a female and **attempted** to take her cell phone and purse. The victim fought off the suspect who fled the area. SUSPECT: Male teenager. **In District 4 at Bay Super Shell, 1800 ½ Powell St.**, a male selected merchandise, told the clerk he had a gun, and left the store. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter, no gun was found. LOSS/RECOVERED: An energy drink and vitamins. **In District 5 in front of Chase Bank, 5747 Christie Ave.**, a female exited the secure ATM area when two males approached her and robbed her of her cash. LOSS: \$100. SUSPECTS: Males wearing black masks, one suspect was armed with a handgun. SUSPECT VEHICLE: OLDER MODEL ACURA, 2-DOOR SILVER. This incident, the Wells Fargo incident, and a similar incident in Newark, CA may be related. **In front of Starbucks Coffee, 5767 Christie Ave.**, a male robbed a female of her laptop and fled to an awaiting vehicle. SUSPECTS: #1 Young male. #2 and #3 males wearing beanies. SUSPECT VEHICLE: FORD, BLACK IN COLOR. **In District 9 at Home Depot, 3838 Hollis St.**, a male juvenile used force against loss prevention agents to steal merchandise. The agents discovered a loaded firearm in the juveniles' waistband. The agents recovered the firearm and turned it over to EPD. EPD arrested the juvenile shortly thereafter. LOSS/RECOVERED: Various tools.

Aggravated Assault: In District 1 on the 12XX block of 63rd St., a female was choked by her roommate's boyfriend. The suspect fled the area prior to police arrival. **In District 3 in the 66XX block Shellmound St.**, a motorist used his vehicle to purposely strike a bicyclist due to a road rage incident. EPD arrested the motorist shortly thereafter. **In District 5 on the 16XX block of Powell St.**, a female was allegedly choked by a male acquaintance. The female is uncooperative with the investigation.

LOSS/RECOVERED: Multiple tools and miscellaneous items. **In District 2 at 58XX Horton St., #XXX** POE: Door – Forced open. LOSS: (2) Apple iPods, and miscellaneous chargers. Suspect: Male wearing dark clothing. **In District 4 at Hong Kong East Ocean, 3199 Powell St.**, POE: Door – Shattered. LOSS: None. **At 3306 Powell St.**, POE: Storage Unit – Padlock cut. LOSS: Marshall's shopping bags and a fan. **At the Emeryville Marina, 3310 Powell St.**, POE: Storage Unit – Lock cut. LOSS: A bicycle, camping gear, and miscellaneous paperwork. **In District 7 at the Emeryville Unified School District, 4727 San Pablo Ave.**, POE: Window – Screen removed. LOSS: An iPad. **At KFC, 4501 San Pablo Ave.**, POE: Door – Left open during a delivery. LOSS: An Amazon tablet.

Residential Burglary: In District 3 at 63XX Christie Ave., #XXX POE: Storage unit. LOSS: Multiple miscellaneous items. **At 63XX Christie Ave #XXX** an **attempted** burglary occurred. **At 63XX Christie Ave., #XXX** POE: Door. No signs of forced entry. LOSS: Clothing. **In District 6 at 15XX Park Ave., #XXX** POE: Door – Key used. LOSS: None. The victim knows the suspect. **In District 8 at 10XX 41st St.**, POE: Back door – Unlocked. LOSS: A camera and camera lens. **At 38XX San Pablo Ave., #XXX** POE: Unknown – No sign of forced entry. LOSS: Jewelry, an iPad, a laptop, and shoes.

Auto Theft: (12) Vehicles were stolen, (5) of which were recovered intact, (3) Vehicles were recovered with damages, and (1) Vehicle was stripped. (3) Vehicles are still outstanding.
