

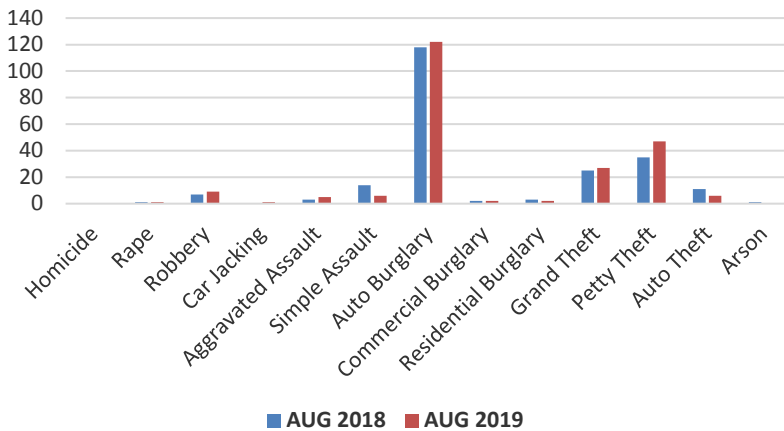

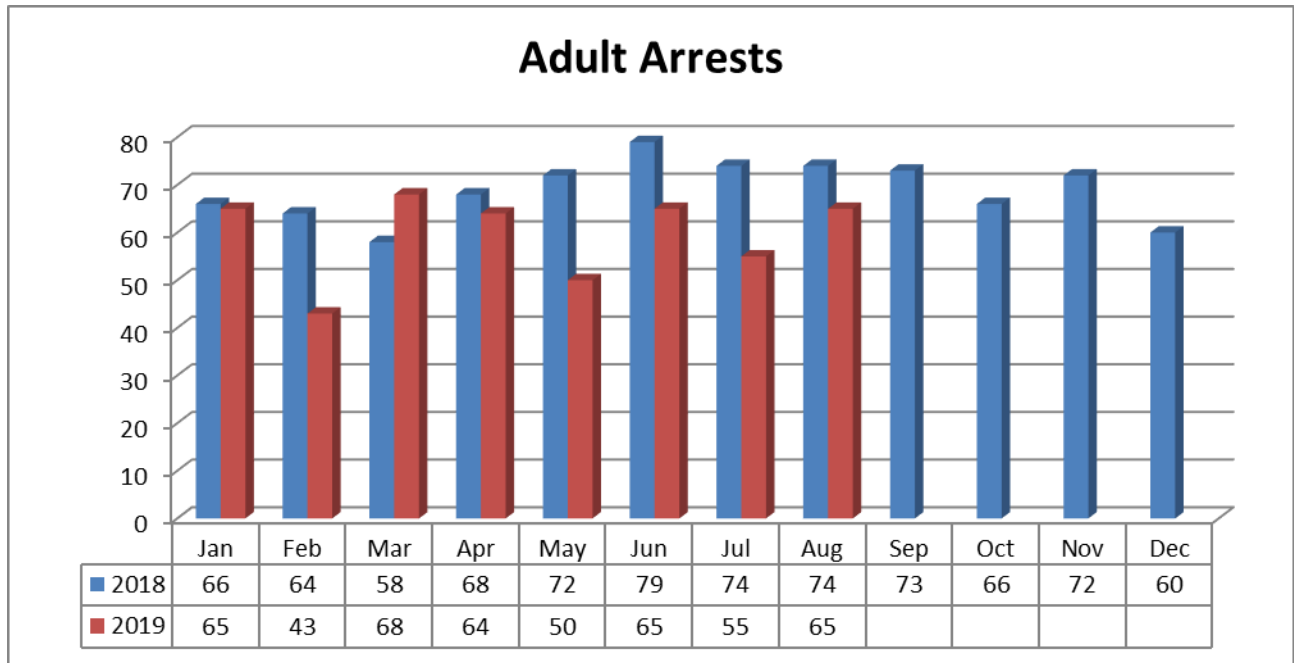

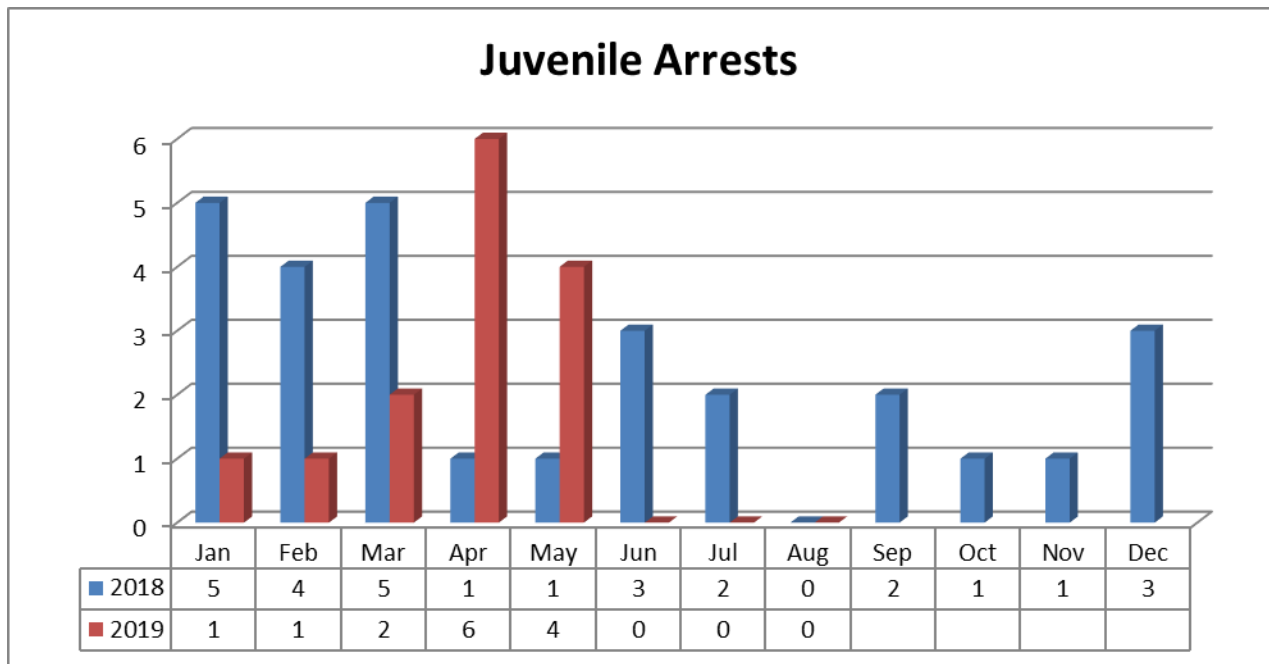

Rape: In District 3 at 64XX Shellmound St., a domestic violence incident resulted in a sexual assault.

Robbery: In District 5 at Victoria's Secret, 5672 Bay St., Shoplifters pulled a knife on the Security Guard, grabbed merchandise and fled the area. SUSPECTS: (3) females. LOSS: Several undergarments. **At Express, 5680 Bay St.,** Shoplifters used force to steal merchandise. SUSPECTS: (3) Females. SUSPECT VEHICLE: 2003 Lexus 300, silver. LOSS: Several pairs of jeans. **At Old Navy, 5625 Bay St.,** a shoplifter used force to steal merchandise. SUSPECT: Female, heavy set, wearing pink leggings. **At American Eagle, 5653 Bay St.,** Shoplifters used force to steal merchandise. SUSPECTS: (2) Males and (2) Females. SUSPECT VEHICLE: 2018 Nissan Altima 4-Door, white. LOSS: Several pairs of pants. **In front of BevMo, 5717 Christie Ave.,** two males wearing hoodies punched two women and took their purses. The suspects fled to a gray Volkswagen SUV and left the area. **In District 6 at Hollis St., & 45th St.,** a robbery at gunpoint occurred. SUSPECT: Male, medium build, 30 years old, wearing a white sweatshirt and black pants. SUSPECT VEHICLE: A newer Audi SUV. LOSS: Backpack containing a laptop, and a wallet. **In District 9 at Home Depot, 3838 Hollis St.,** a known shoplifter used force to steal merchandise. SUSPECT: Male, wearing a Raider's jersey with #24, LOSS: (3) Makita Drills, (2) were recovered.

At Ulta, 3839 Emery St., #200 two shoplifters used force to steal merchandise and said they had a gun. (No gun seen). SUSPECTS: (1) Male and (1) Female. LOSS: Perfume. **In District 10 at Target, 1555 40th St.,** a shoplifter used force to steal merchandise. SUSPECT: Female. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter.

Car Jacking: In District 5 in the parking lot of the Courtyard By Marriot, 5555 Shellmound St., a female was carjacked and robbed. LOSS: Backpack and rental vehicle, Chevy Camaro. Oakland Police located the vehicle the next day.

Aggravated Assault: In District 4 at Powell St., & Frontage Rd., a domestic violence incident resulted in a male jumping on the hood of his girlfriend's vehicle while she was driving. The girlfriend eventually stopped the vehicle allowing the male to get off the hood (No injuries). The girlfriend left the area. **In District 6 in the area of Park Ave & Halleck St.,** a motorist shot several rounds at another motorist. Both parties were gone on police arrival. **At 57XX Peladeau St.,** a domestic violence incident resulted in a female hitting her husband with a broom handle. EPD arrested the female shortly thereafter. **In District 8 at W MacArthur Bl & Adeline St.,** a male stabbed a family member. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter.

Commercial Burglary: In District 4 at the Marina 3310 Powell St., (secured laundry room), an unknown suspect broke into the laundry machine and stole quarters. LOSS: \$100. **In District 6 at Pettitpot, 4221 Horton St.,** POE: Door – Ajar. LOSS: Laptop, tablet and Visa card. Suspect: A male wearing a bandana over half of his face, wearing a green shirt, brown vest, dark pants, and red shoes.

Residential Burglary: In District 3 at 64XX Christie Ave #XXXX POE: Patio door. LOSS: Purse. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. **District 4 at X Commodore Dr., #XXX** POE: Front door – Pried. LOSS: Laptop, women's jewelry, backpack, camera, men's watch, and men's sunglasses. SUSPECTS: (3) Males wearing jeans and t-shirts. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Maroon Volkswagen SUV.

Auto Theft: (6) Vehicles were stolen including (1) motorcycle (still outstanding). (5) Vehicles were recovered, (2) of which were recovered intact, (2) vehicles were damaged, and (1) vehicle had minor stripping. Various foreign makes were stolen.
