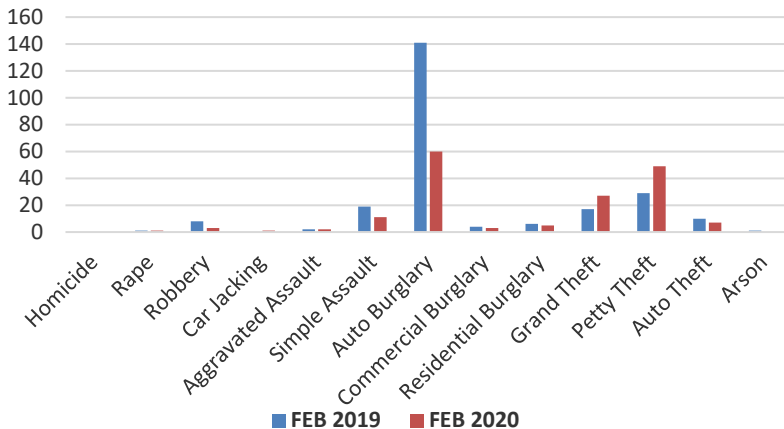

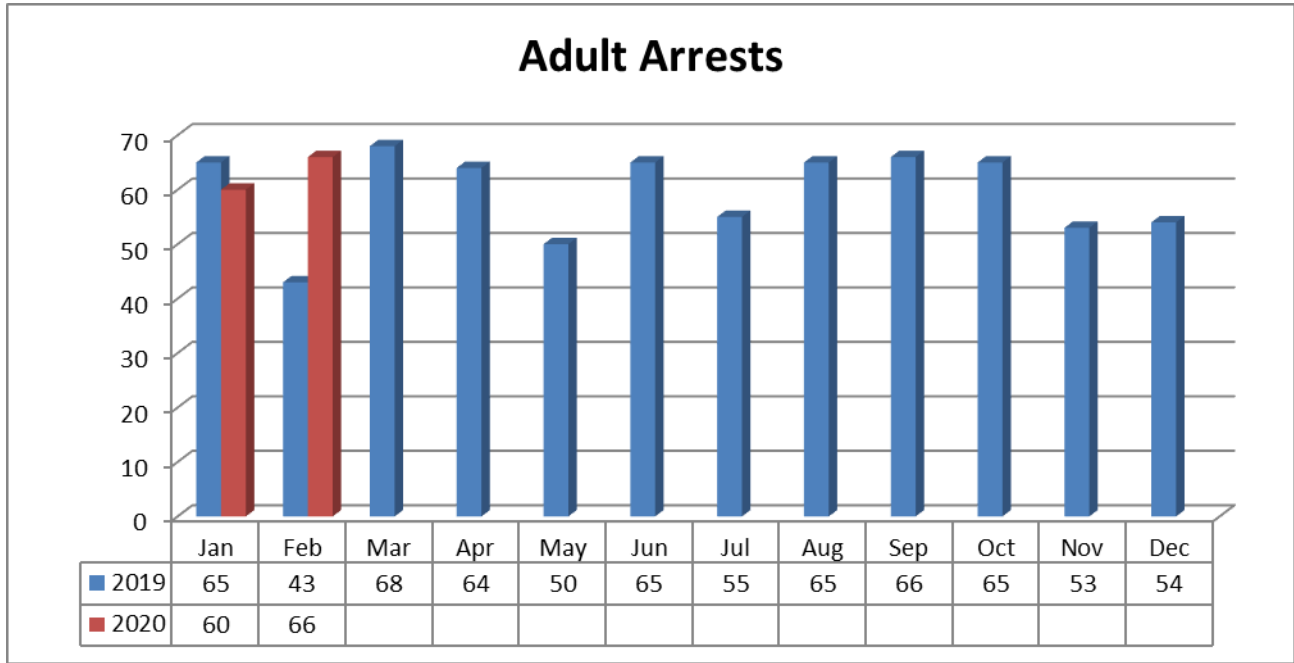

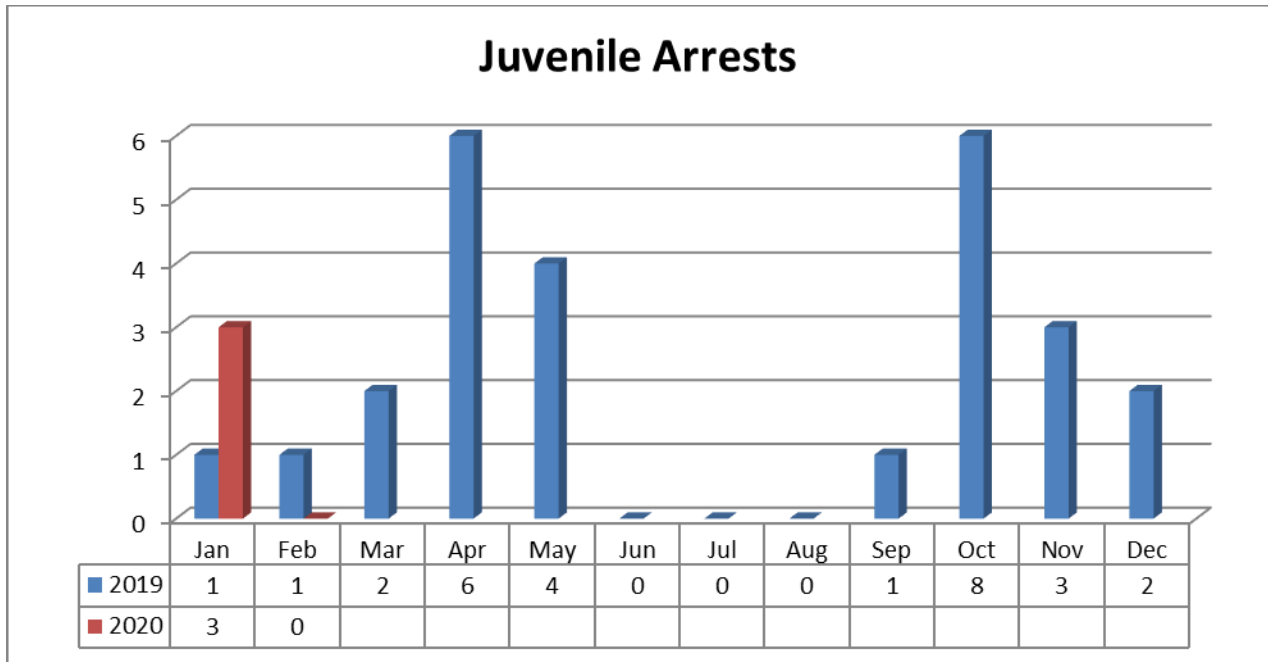

Rape: In District 4 at the Emeryville Marina, 3300 Powell St., a female was raped by two male acquaintances.

Robbery: In District 3 on the 6300 block of Shellmound St., a male suspect approached two female victims from behind while they were walking. The suspect grabbed one victim's backpack and demanded both victim's cell phones. The suspect was wearing a hoody and had his hand in his pocket simulating a gun or an unknown weapon. LOSS: A Cell phone, (1) tote bag containing computer equipment, and (1) backpack containing personal property. The suspect fled the area on foot. SUSPECT: Male, wearing a black hoody pulled up over his head, dark jeans and gloves. **At 64th & Shellmound St.**, a robbery at gun point occurred. LOSS: Backpack containing miscellaneous personal property. SUSPECT: Female, 30s, short hair pulled back, 5'3", heavy build, wearing a dark shirt. SUSPECT VEHICLE: A small dusty blue 2-Door, unknown make. **In District 7 on the 1200 block of 53rd St.**, (ATTEMPT) three male suspects approached a male victim while he was walking home from work and talking on his cell phone. The suspects attempted to take the victim's cell phone however they were unsuccessful and fled the area.

Carjacking: In District 3 in the parking lot of the Hyatt House, 5800 Shellmound St., a male suspect carjacked a vehicle at knifepoint. VICTIM VEHICLE: 2005 Toyota Corolla 4-Door, black.

Aggravated Assault: In District 8 at 36XX Peralta St. #XXX a domestic violence incident resulted in the male striking and choking his wife. Hayward P.D. arrested the suspect and turned him over to EPD. **At 3815 San Pablo Ave.**, an EPD officer was injured while attempting to arrest a burglary suspect. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter.

Commercial Burglary: In District 5 at 56XX Bay St., #XXX a storage locker was burgled. There was no sign of forced entry. LOSS: Speakers, musical instruments, and tools. **In District 8 at the German International School, 1070 41st St.**, a classroom was burgled. There was no sign of forced entry. LOSS: A water bottle, children's books, a first aid kit, a coffee maker, a stereo, and a gray cushion. **In District 9 at Nordstrom Rack, 3839 Emery St., #100.**, a repeat female offender committed fraudulent credit transactions. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter.

Residential Burglary: In District 3 at 64XX Christie Ave., #XXX POE: Sliding glass door. LOSS: A laptop, a camera, several pairs of shoes and other personal items. **In District 6 at 43XX Horton St.** POE: Storage locker. LOSS: Bicycle. **In District 8 at 10XX 41st.**, an unknown suspect entered the mail room and stole multiple packages. **At 10XX 41st St.**, POE: Rear door – Kicked in. LOSS: None. **At 46XX Adeline St, #XXX (ATTEMPT)** an unknown suspect attempted to pry the front door open.

Auto Theft: (7) Vehicles were stolen this month, (2) of which were recovered intact, (2) vehicles were damaged, (2) vehicles had minor stripping, and (1) vehicle is still outstanding. Honda Civics and Accords were the most popular vehicles.
