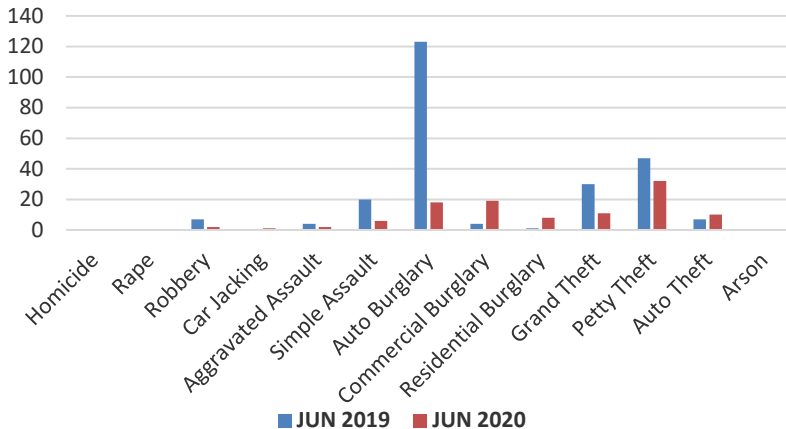

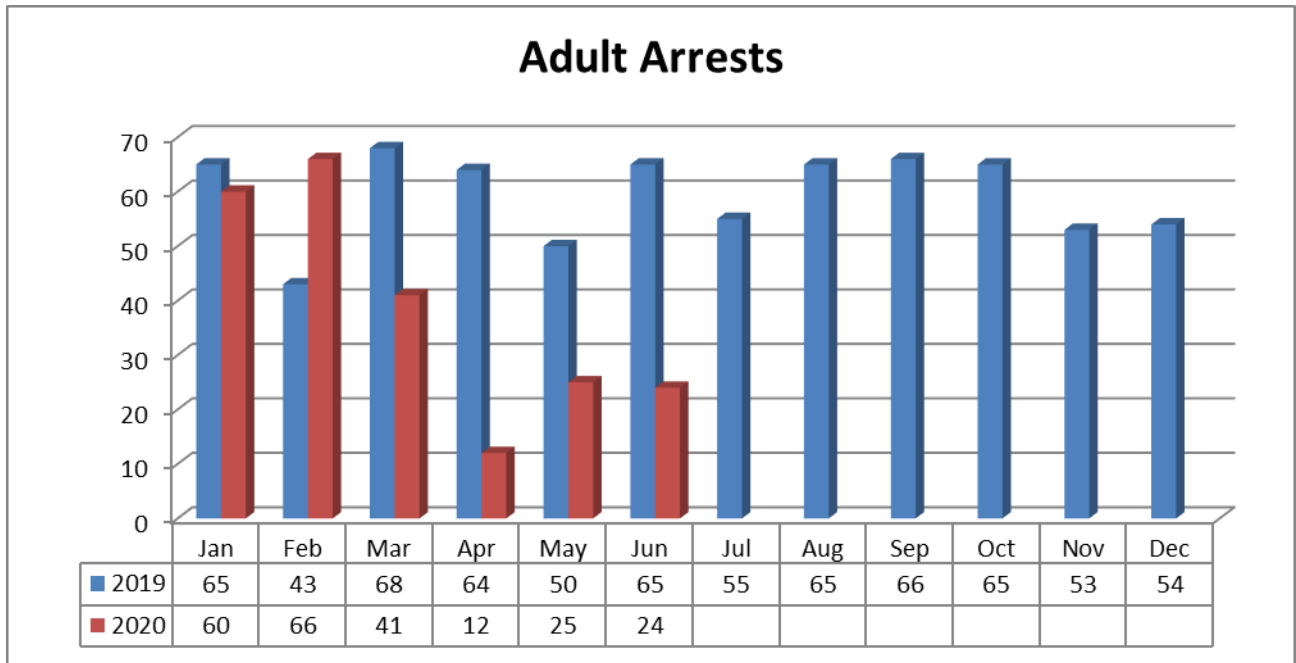

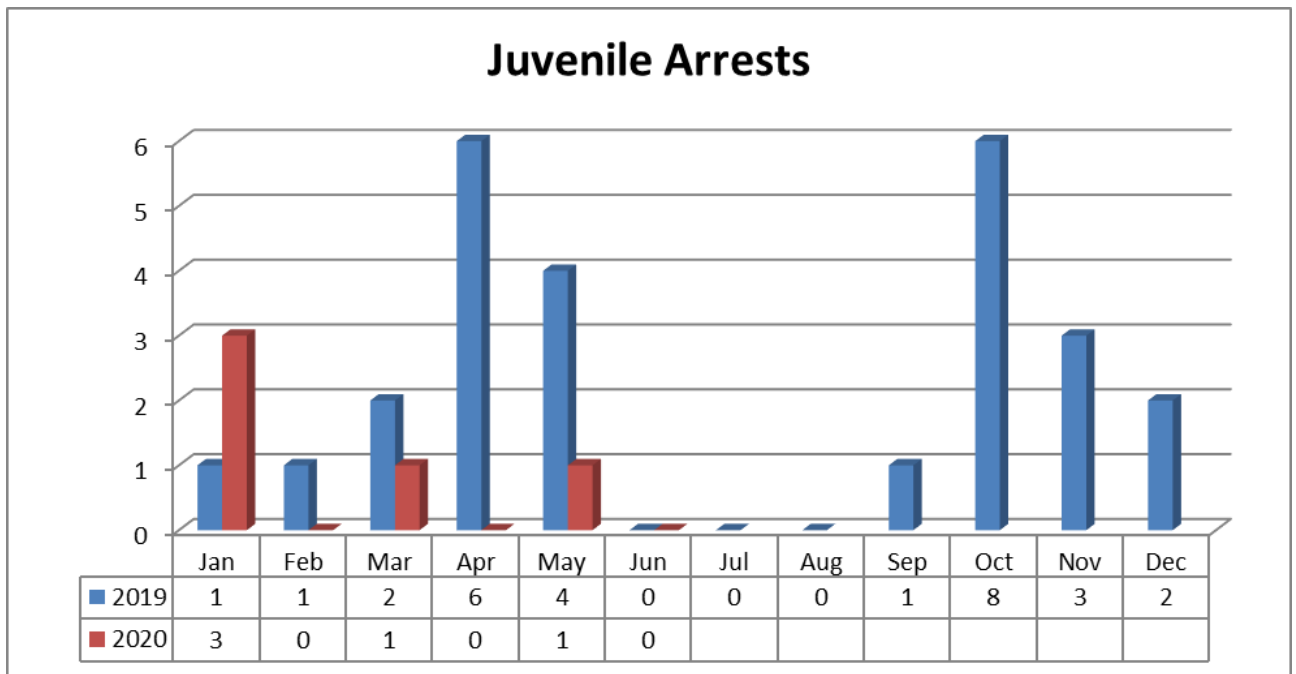

Robbery: In District 8 a Lane Splitter Pizza, 3645 San Pablo Ave, a mentally ill male stole a computer tablet and swung a pipe wrench at a customer. SUSPECT: Male, no shirt, wearing light blue boxers and black shoes. LOSS/Recovered: Apple iPad. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. **In District 9 in front of Pak N Save, 3889 San Pablo Ave.,** a male suspect stole a females' wallet, cash, and cell phone during an altercation.
