

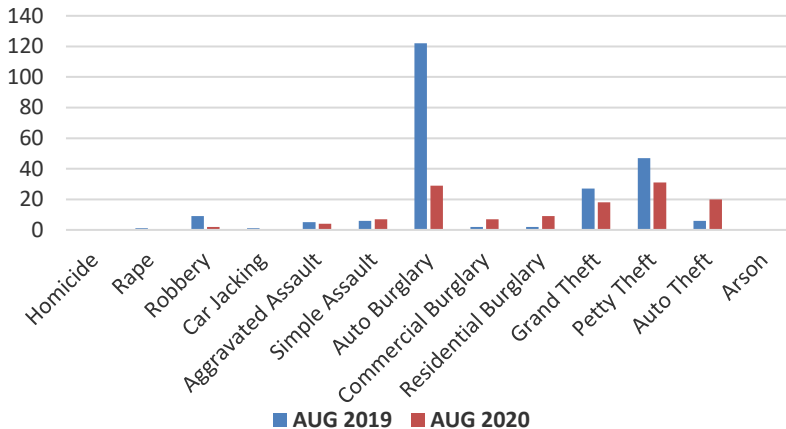

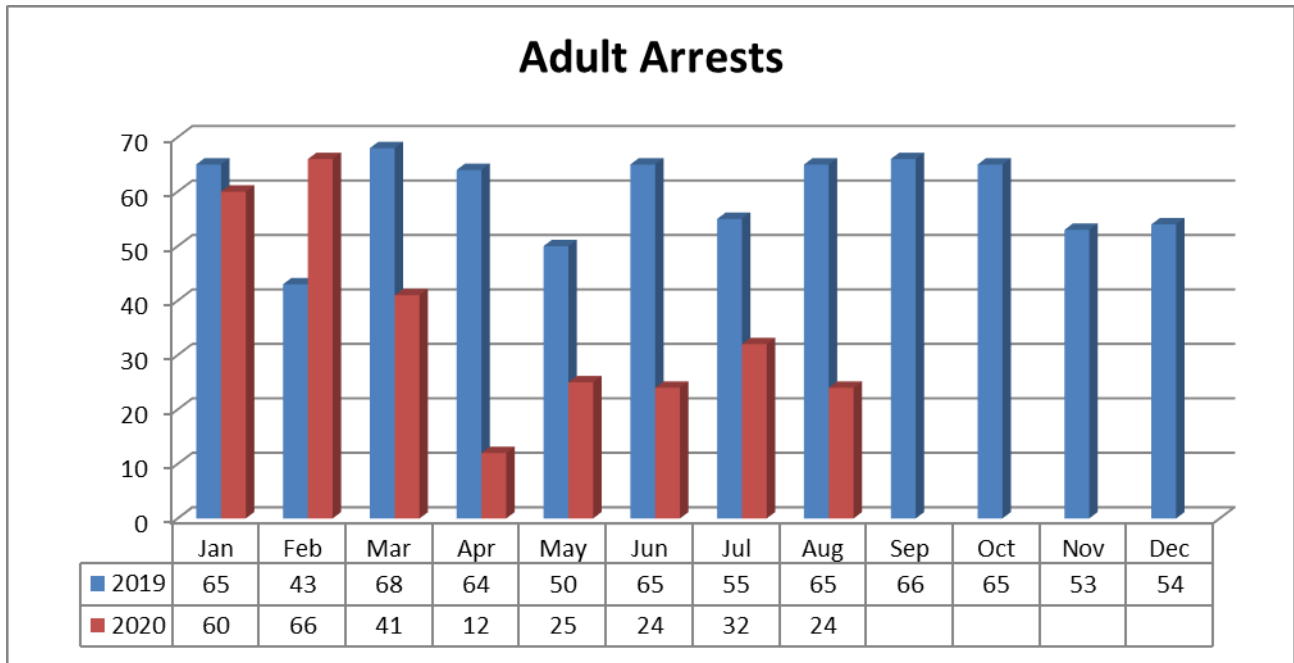

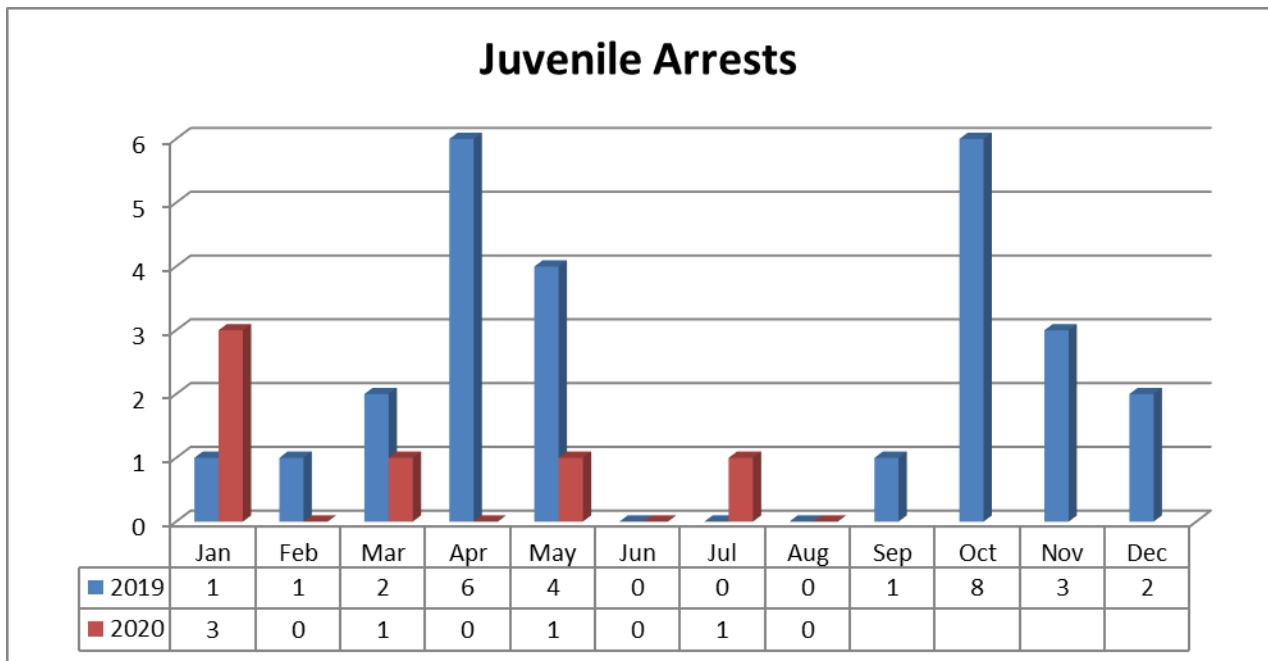
Adult and Juvenile Arrests YTD 2019 and 2020

Robbery: In District 4 at 4 Anchor Dr., (Garage) a strong-arm robbery occurred. Victim: 78 year old female. LOSS: Cash and car key from the victim's purse. The purse was located at the scene. SUSPECT: Male, late teens. In District 5 at Sun Glass Hut 5673 Bay St., a strong-arm robbery occurred. LOSS: (2) pairs of sun glasses. SUSPECT: Male shoplifter, 20-30 years old, wearing a black baseball cap and black clothing. The suspect rode away on a black bicycle.

Aggravated Assault: In District 1 on the 5800 block of Beaudry St., a domestic violence incident resulted in the male choking the female. EPD arrested the suspect shortly thereafter. At 11XX 40th St., POE: Bicycle Room – Lock cut off bicycle. LOSS: A Bicycle. In District 9 at 12XX 40th St., #XXX POE: Front door – Pried open. LOSS: A computer laptop.

Auto Theft: (20) Vehicles were stolen this month. (15) Vehicles were recovered, (10) of which were recovered intact, (3) vehicles had minor stripping, (2) vehicles were damaged, and (5) vehicles are still outstanding. Hondas were the most popular vehicles stolen.
