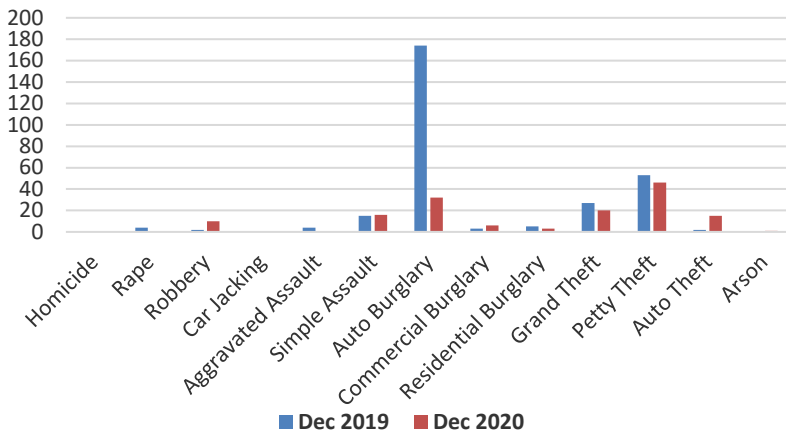

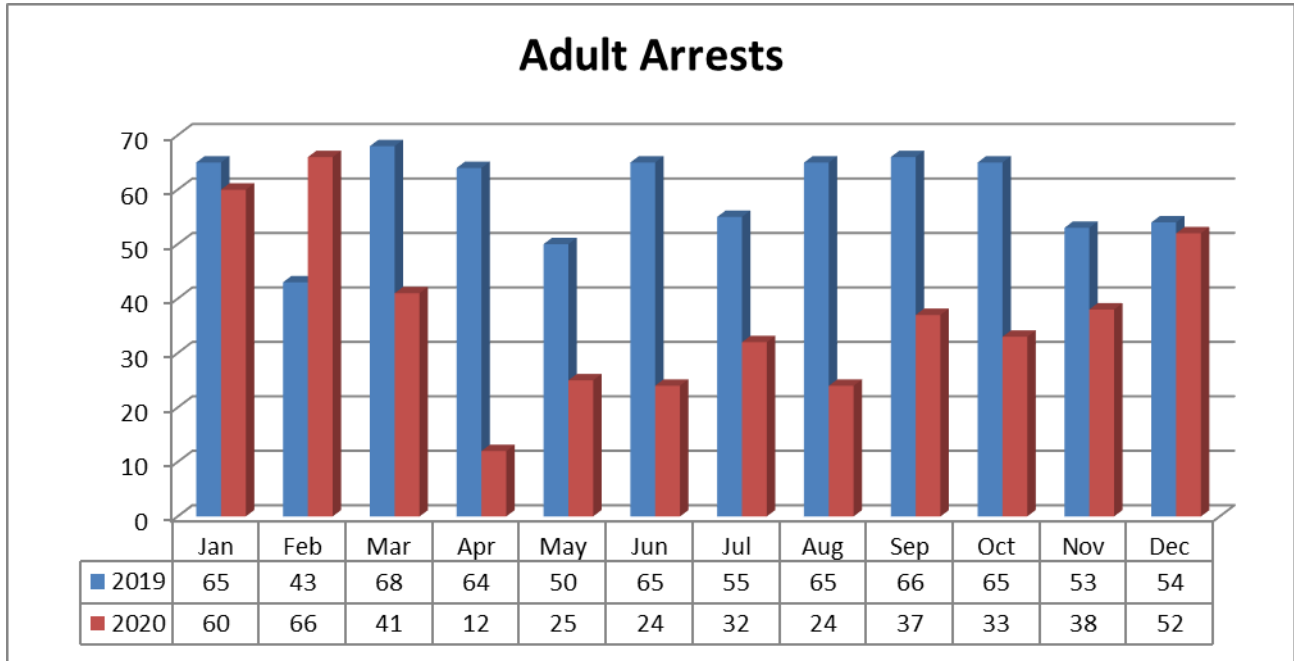

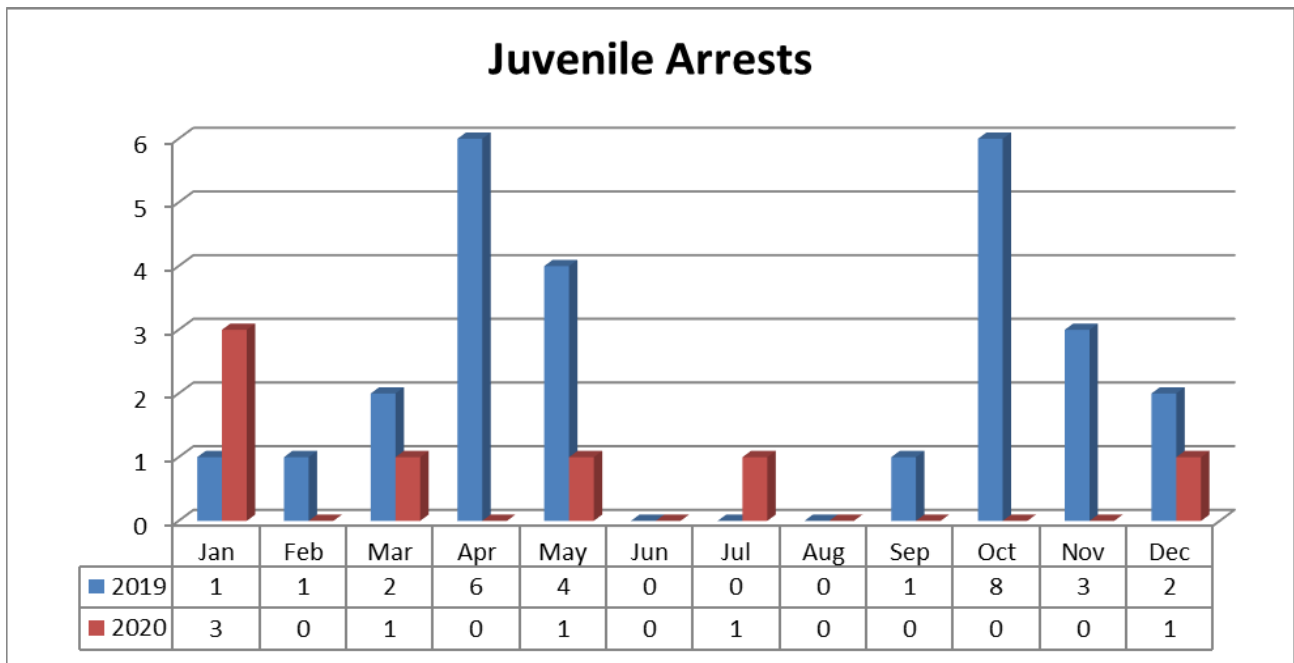
Adult and Juvenile Arrests YTD 2019 and 2020

Robbery: In District 5 in the parking lot near Trader Joe's, 5700 Christie Ave., a strong-arm robbery occurred. LOSS: Cell phone. SUSPECTS: #1 Unknown. #2 Male, 13-14 years old, 5'4", wearing a light-colored hoodie and jeans. SUSPECT VEHICLE: White 4-door vehicle. **In District 7 at CVS Pharmacy, 4349 San Pablo Ave.,** two male shoplifters grabbed bottles of liquor. One suspect brandished a bottle of liquor at a store employee, while the other suspect fled out of the rear door with the loss. LOSS: Multiple bottles of liquor. SUSPECTS: #1 Male wearing a black shirt and blue jeans. #2 Unknown. **At CVS Pharmacy, 4349 San Pablo Ave.,** three females entered the store, grabbed items from the shelves, and made their way to the front of the store passing all points of sale. An employee grabbed a blanket from one of the suspects, however the suspect forcefully pulled the blanket back, and fled the store. LOSS: Various items. **In District 8 in the alley way on the eastern side of Bank of America, 4120 San Pablo Ave.,** a strong-arm robbery occurred. LOSS: A purse. SUSPECT: Male, no further description. SUSPECT VEHICLE: Black 4-door sedan. **At 7-Eleven, 4000 San Pablo Ave.,** a shoplifter used force and brandished a knife to steal merchandise. LOSS: An unknown beverage, and a dog leash. SUSPECT: Male, 30 years old, 5'9", 200 lbs., bushy hair, wearing a black jacket and black acid wash jeans. The suspect fled the area riding a red bicycle. **At 7-Eleven, 4000 San Pablo Ave.,** a shoplifter used force to steal merchandise. LOSS: (2) Muffins. SUSPECT: Male, 5'5", 170 lbs., wearing a black jacket and jeans. The suspect fled on a red bicycle. **In District 9 in the parking lot of Pak N Save., 3889 San Pablo Ave.,** a male grabbed an elderly females' purse causing the female to fall to the ground. LOSS: Purse contained \$400 cash, a passport, car keys, and cell phone. The suspects later returned and stole the victim's vehicle, a 2015 Audi Q3. Oakland Police Department recovered the vehicle three weeks later.

In District 9 at Home Depot, 3838 Hollis St., a shoplifter used force to steal merchandise. LOSS: Husky Backpack containing tools. SUSPECT: Male, 5'7", 180, wearing a black beanie, a gray neck gator, a tan jacket, and blue jeans. The suspect fled on foot. **In District 10 in the Target parking lot, 1555 40th St.,** a group of four to five juveniles attacked a male, pushed him to the ground and removed his backpack. SUSPECTS: Unknown genders, skinny build, and under 6-feet. **In the Target parking lot, 1555 40th.** An attempted robbery occurred. A female was seated on the driver side of her vehicle with the door open. A male juvenile approached the victim's vehicle and punched the victim. The victim was able to close and lock her vehicle door. The suspects fled the area. SUSPECTS: #1 Male, 11 years old, short hair, wearing blue jeans. #2 Unknown number of suspects. SUSPECT VEHICLE: A white sedan parked nearby with a driver in the vehicle.

An unknown suspect(s) knocked on the door and rang the doorbell. An EPD officer found scratch marks on the door near the door frame.

Arson: In District 4 at Powell & I-80 freeway overcrossing, an unknown suspect set fire to a tent.
