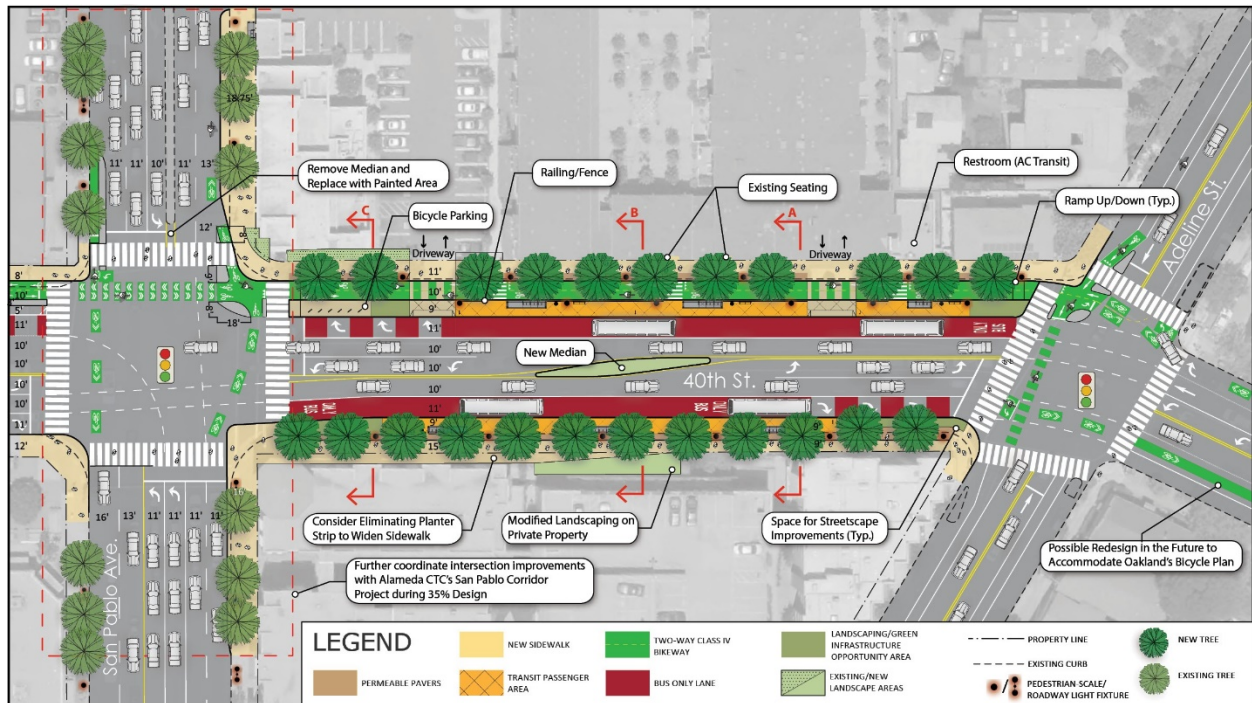
From Oakland border to IKEA entry

Bus-only lanes

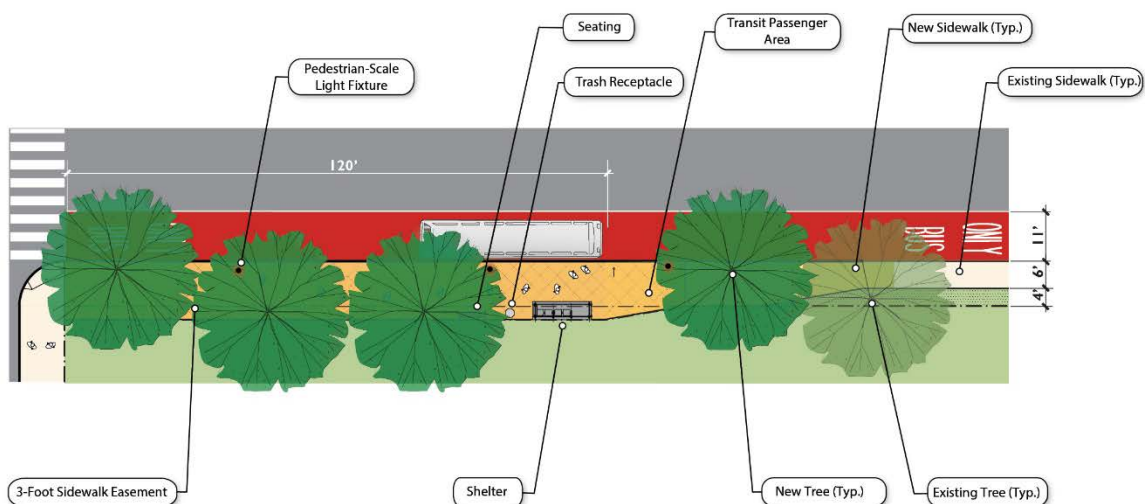
Two-way bikeway on north side of street

Top Priorities for Public Art

1. Expanding bus shelter art program into the new shelters

Integrated into functional elements – railings, benches, light fixtures, trash bins, or paving

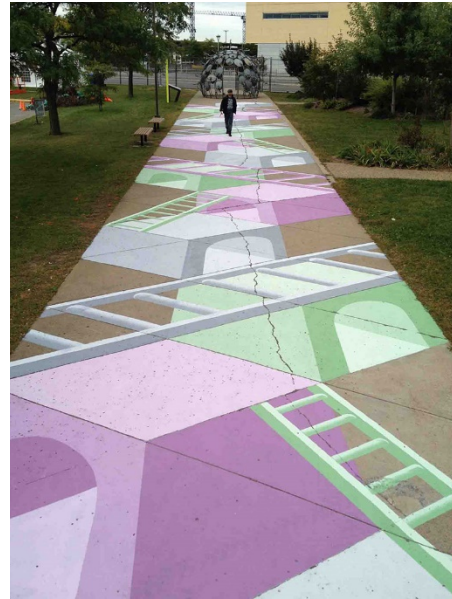
