  - 5.1. Emeryville Child Development Center (Desiree (**Rebecca in Desiree's Absence**)) -
    - Started last week and do a slow roll enrollment about 48 children started
    - A lot of new wobblers (1-2yrs)
    - Started enrolling infants (6 mo+) due to need with TK at school
    - Hiring for new teacher assistant & just closed interviews
    - With recent teacher retirement Tanya James has done a great job in acting role
    - ECDC covered by Measure F funds out of the 56 spots 18 are covered by CSPP eligible families
  - 5.2. Youth Services (Christen) -
    - First summer taking over the entire summer school program after school added about 100
    - Some Field Trips: Giants Game, Cull Canyon
    - Kids had about 12 activities every week in the summer
    - Currently hiring about 5 Rec Lead staff and 3 Special Education staff for the school year
    - Current afterschool waitlist hopefully enrolled by October 1
    - Youth sports (returning soon) run by Lemon Peppa who will also be Teen Coordinator.




