



ECCL FACILITY AND POOL RULES

- **Be Respectful and follow all facility rules.**
- All participants must check in and sign the waiver.
- Obey the lifeguards and facility staff; they are here for your safety.
- In the case of an emergency, call 911 and notify a lifeguard or facility staff.
- No pets, glass, alcoholic beverages, smoking/vaping, illegal drugs. Patrons must not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Lockers are bring-own-lock and first come, first serve. Locker must be emptied by the end of your visit. Locks remaining on lockers overnight will be cut off and contents placed in lost-and-found.
- City of Emeryville and EUSD are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Inappropriate behavior will result in immediate removal from the premises.
- All swimmers must shower before entering the pool.
- Photography/filming are prohibited, unless pre-authorized by Aquatics Management.
- No running, diving, roughhousing, underwater breath-holding, chicken fights or “piggyback” rides.
- Swimmers may jump in the pool feet first, facing forward; no twisting/spinning.
- No eating, drinking, or chewing gum while swimming.
- To prevent illness transmission, patrons who’ve had diarrhea in the last 14 days cannot enter the pool.
- Personal private swim lessons (not sanctioned by the city of Emeryville) are prohibited.
- Patrons must exit the facility within 15 minutes of program ending.
- Appropriate swim attire is required:
 - **Allowed:** swim trunks, swimsuits, athletic apparel, jammers, swim shirt/rash guards, wetsuits, swim diapers
 - **Prohibited:** cotton, denim, undergarments, excessively baggy or soiled clothing, beaded jewelry, clothing with metal features such as zippers, rivets, or chains
 - Our swim attire policy has been established to provide swimmers with a safe and inclusive experience, while protecting the pool system from contaminants and damage (i.e. cotton fibers clogging pool filters). If you require special accommodations, please contact aquatic staff.
- **Violation of any rule may result in immediate removal from the premises.**
