CITIZEN ACADEMY RULES

1. Dress for participants during each class session will be casual business attire (slacks or dress pants) with a collared shirt.
2. Food, Soft drinks, water and coffee are permitted during sessions.
3. Unless otherwise noted, all classes will be held at the Emeryville Police Department and will commence promptly at 6:00PM.
4. Participants are required to live, work or have a child attending school within the city limits of Emeryville, have no felony convictions, no misdemeanor convictions within the past 3 years, and be at least 18 years old.
5. The class will be limited to 20 students per session.
6. Portions of written and/or verbal instructions detailed during any class session may be of a confidential and/or sensitive nature. Participants are asked to treat this information accordingly.
7. There is no charge for your participation in the Citizen's Police Academy. However, your commitment of time is required.
8. Unforeseen circumstances and unavoidable commitments do arise. However, no more than two excused absences, or one unexcused absence are allowed during the academy session. Anyone sustaining more than two absences will be dropped from the program. If you are required to be absent, please notify the Administrative Services Division as soon as possible at 510-596-3717.
9. Patrol ride alongs are optional.
10. Any rule may be waived or modified upon review and approval of the Chief.
